 lasting option possible.
- Opt for used products. Reuse or rethink what you already have or purchase a "gently used" item from a resale/thrift shop. Browse reuse websites (listed on reverse) or share/trade items with friends and neighbors.
- Choose reusables. Make it a habit to use travel mugs, reusable water bottles, and reusable shopping bags/totes.
