### **Evangelii Gaudium Sunday**

This year we celebrate **Evangelii Gaudium** this Sunday, 21<sup>st</sup> September, a day dedicated to the domestic mission of the Catholic Church in England and Wales. Inspired by Pope Francis' The Joy of the Gospel, it reminds us that each of us is called to be a missionary disciple, sharing our faith with joy in our parishes, schools, and communities. The 2025 theme, "I believe...", marks the 1,700<sup>th</sup>

anniversary of the Council of Nicaea, where the Creed we profess each Sunday was first formulated. On this day, let us renew our commitment to living out that Creed, building our lives on its truth, and joyfully witnessing to the Gospel. The second collection supports mission offered by CBCEW.
