

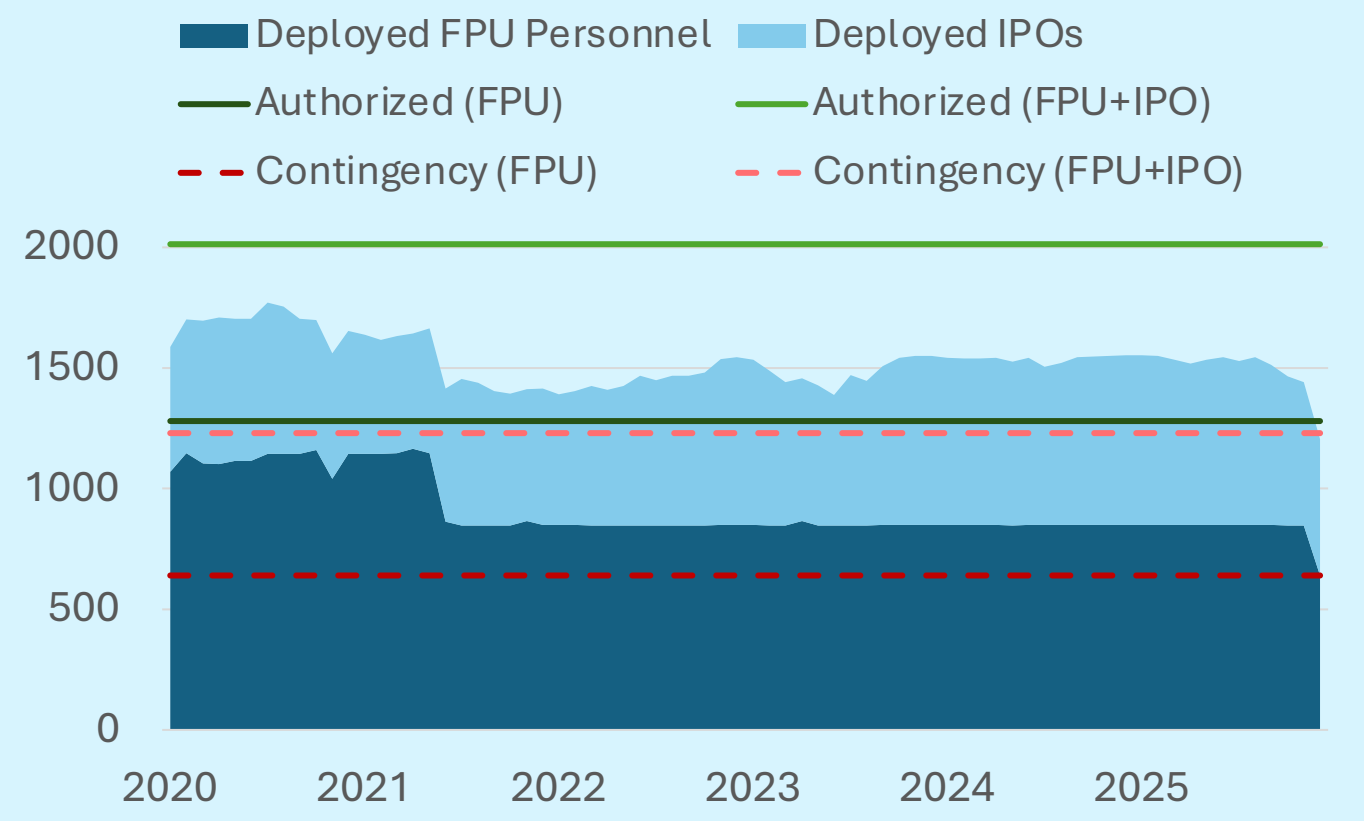

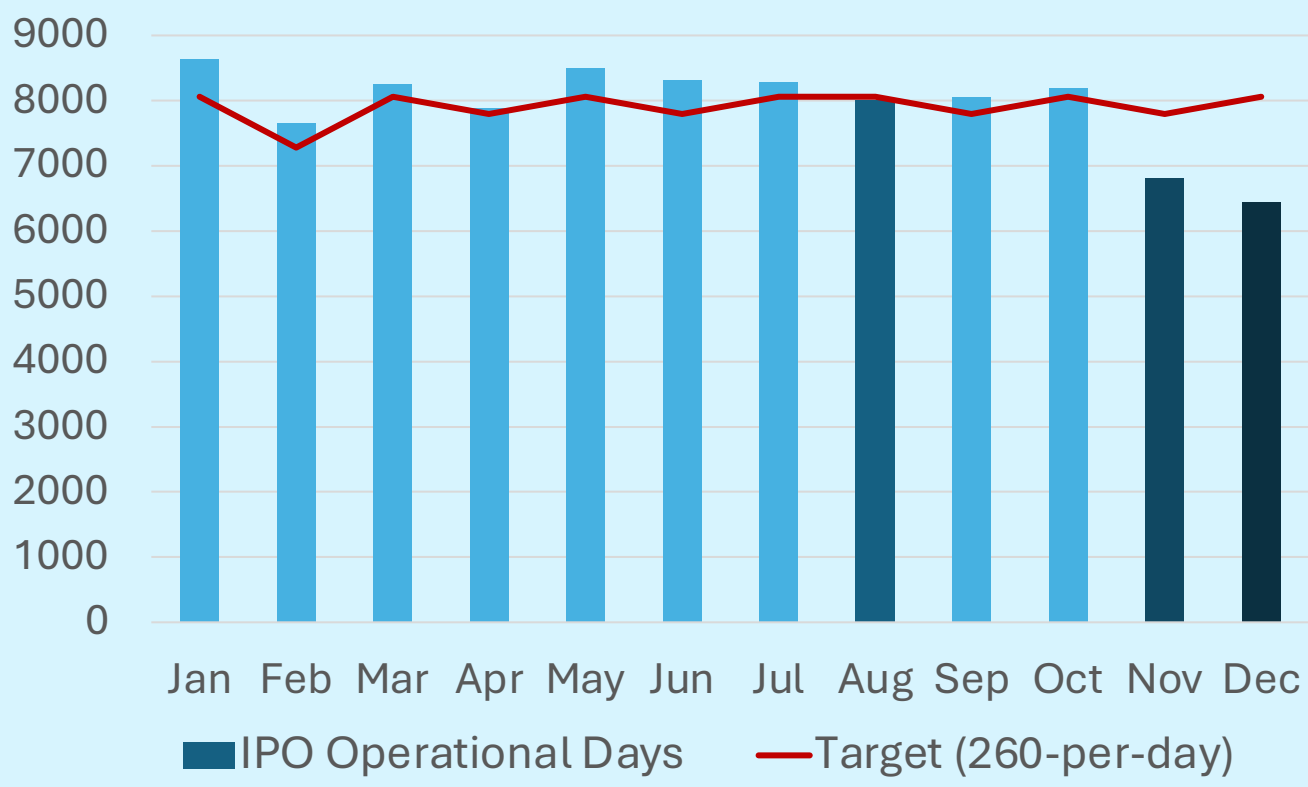

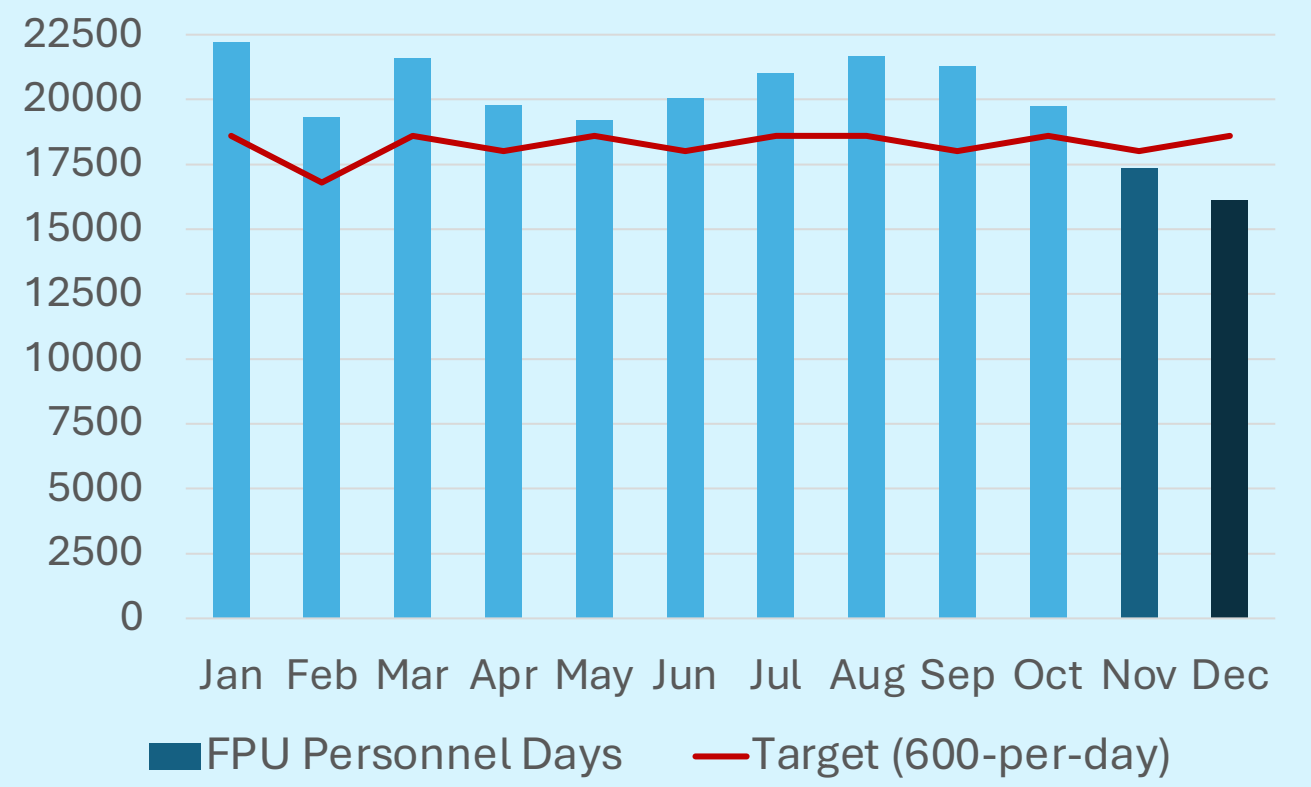


IPO Operational Days per month

FPU Daily Personnel on Duty per month

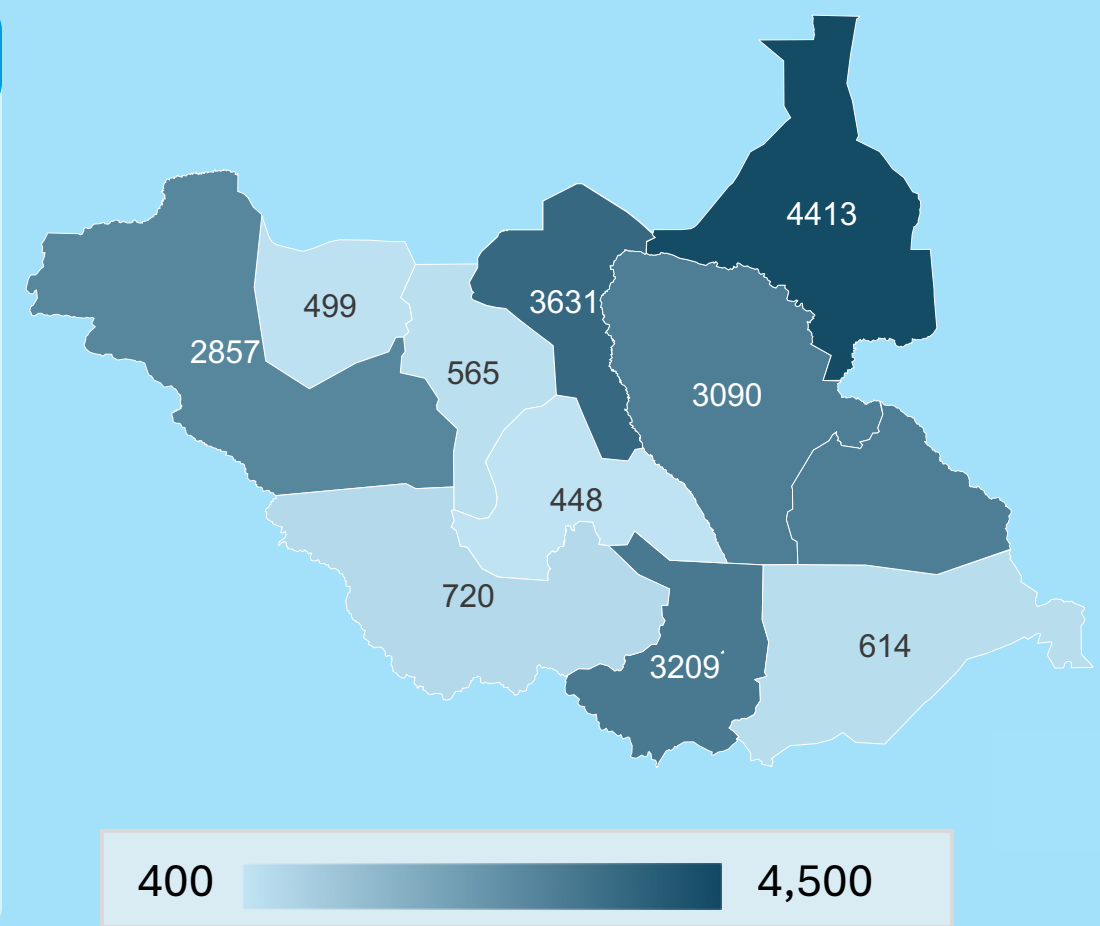
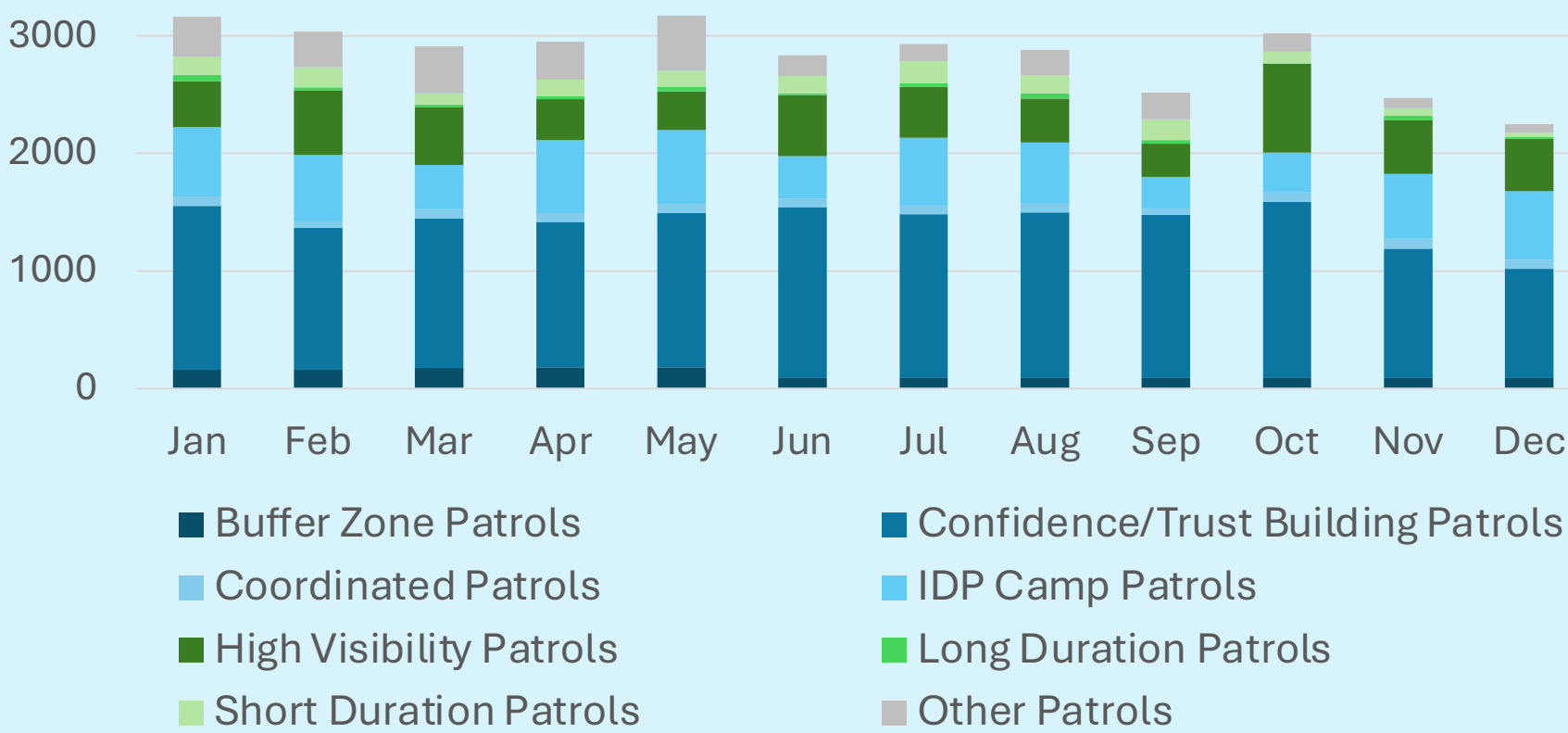


FPU personnel per day providing PoC and operational support

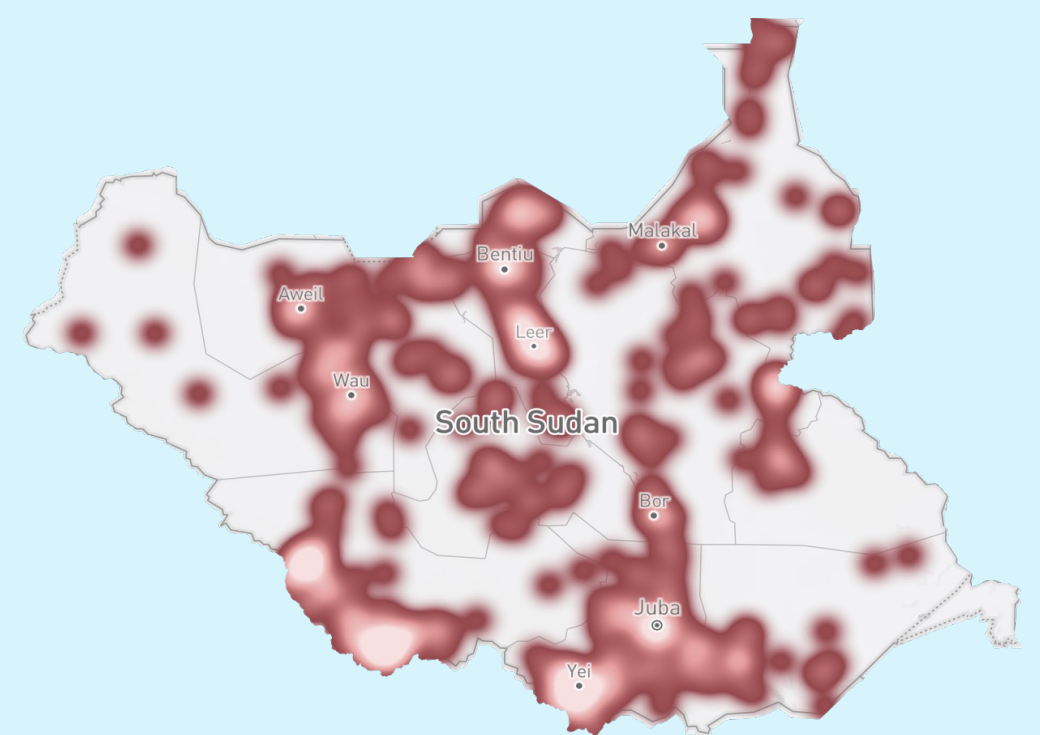
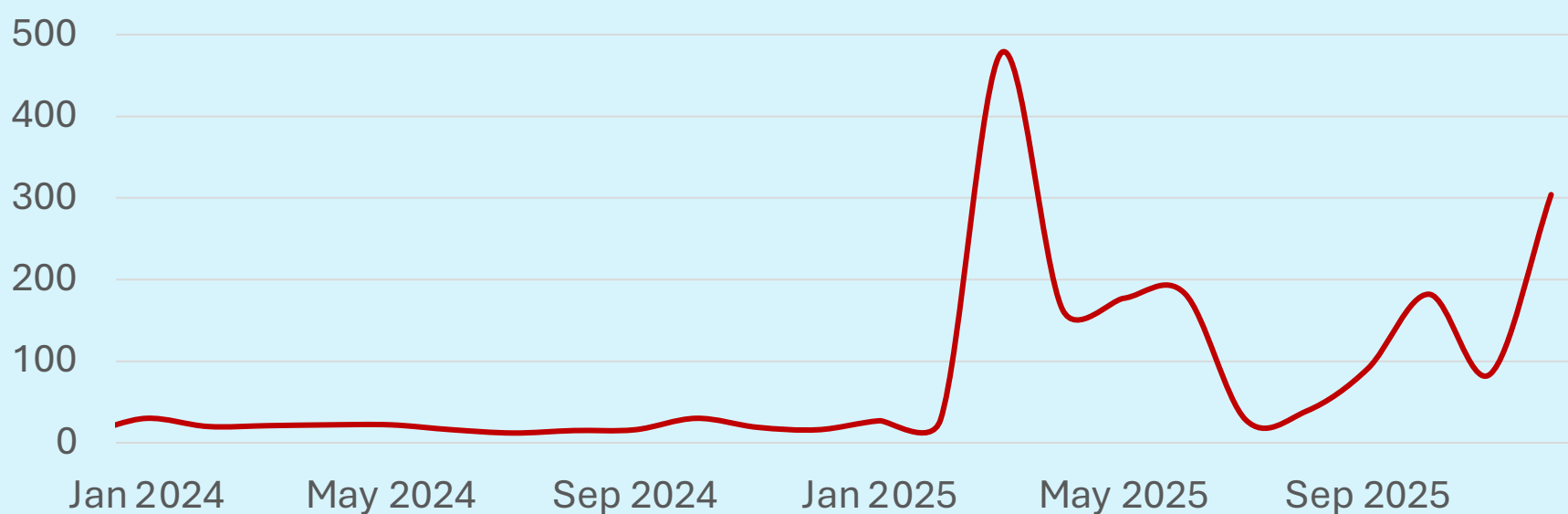
Operational Alert

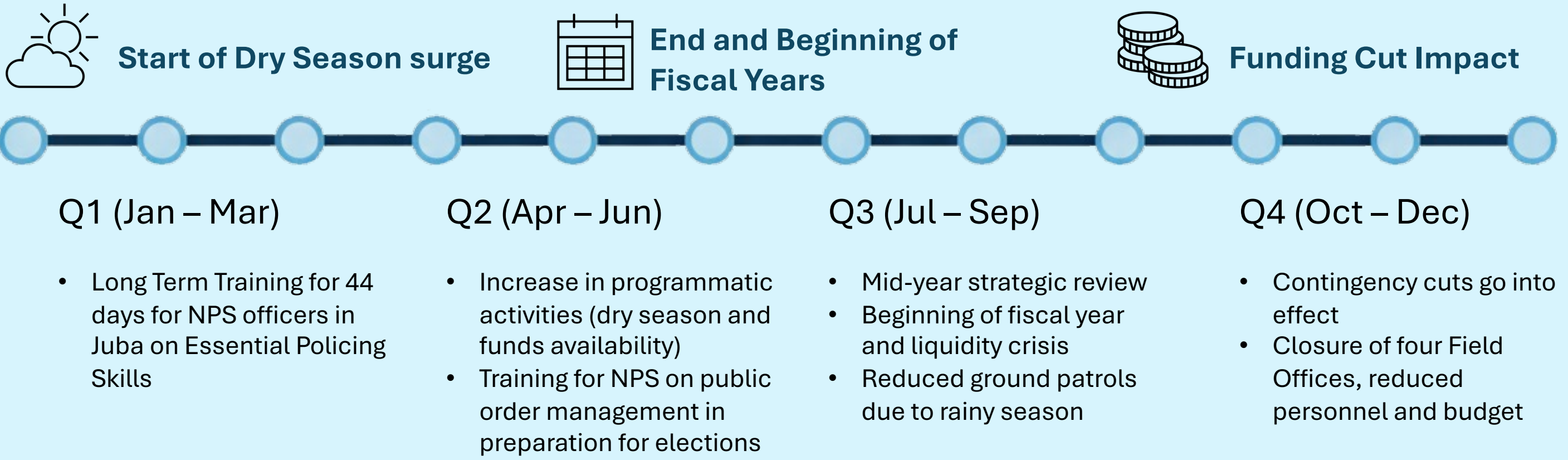

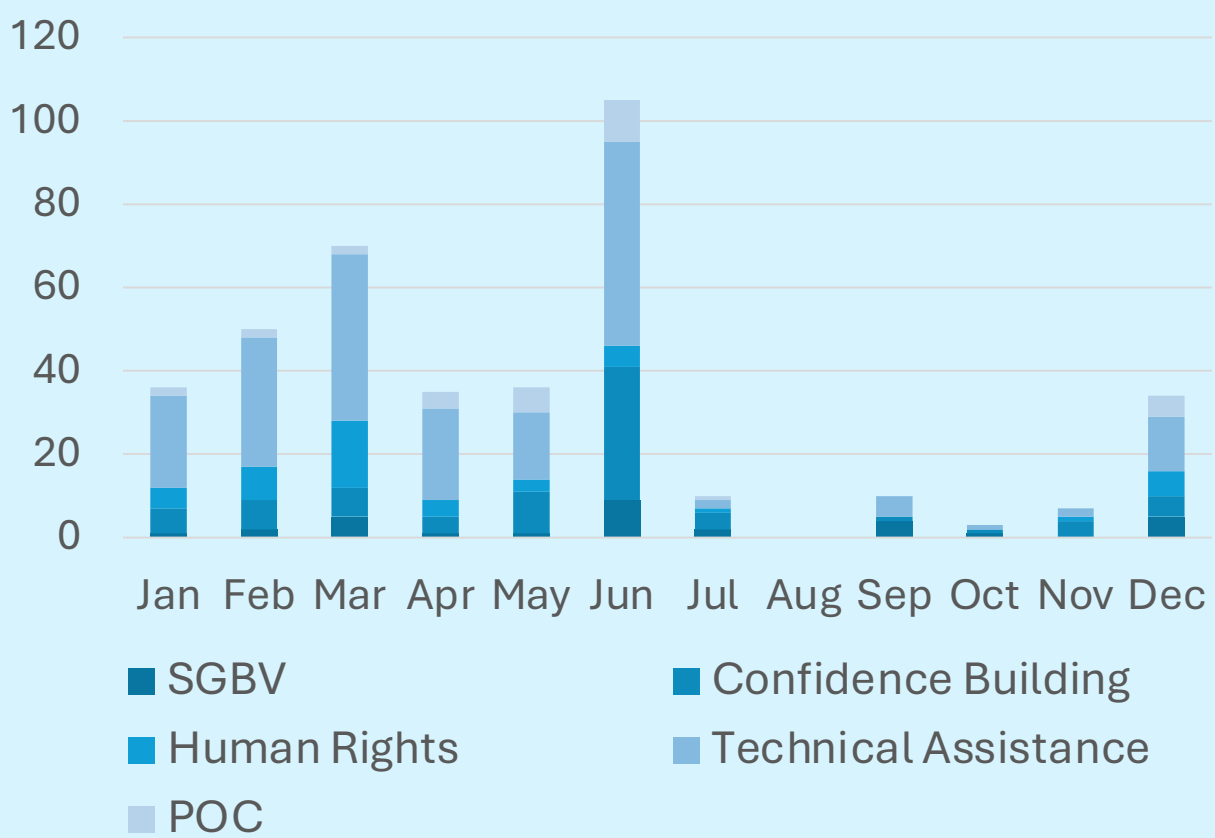

UNPOL 2025 Timeline



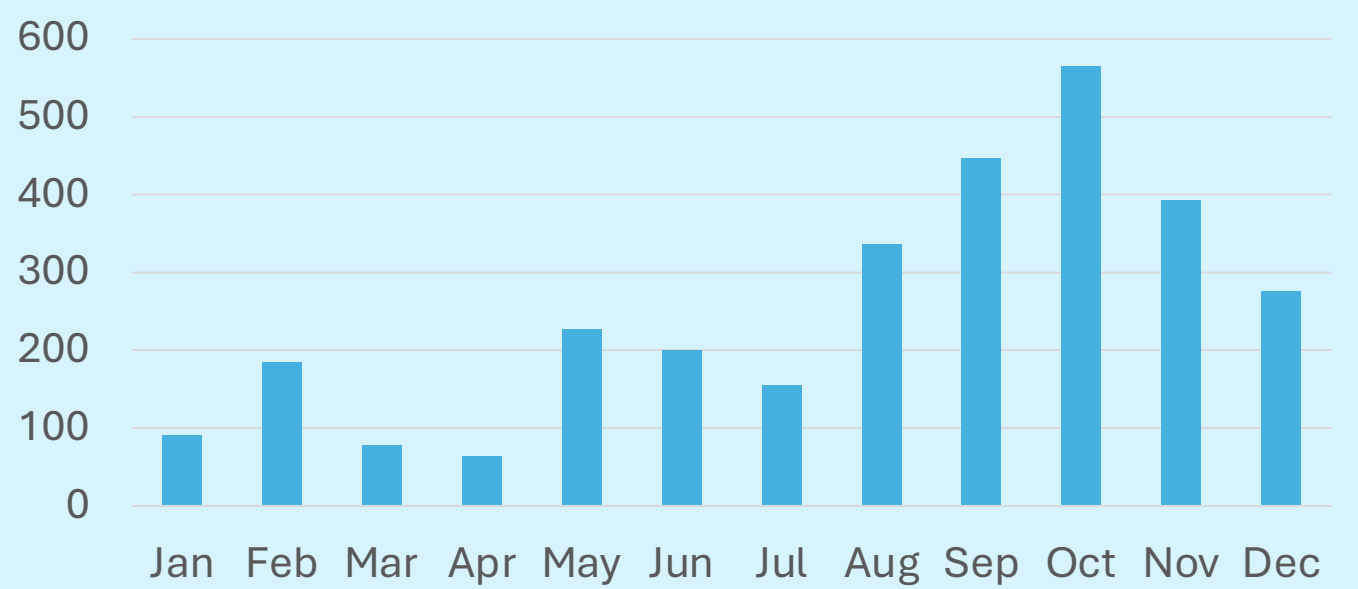
