## UNPOL Personnel and Patrolling Statistics

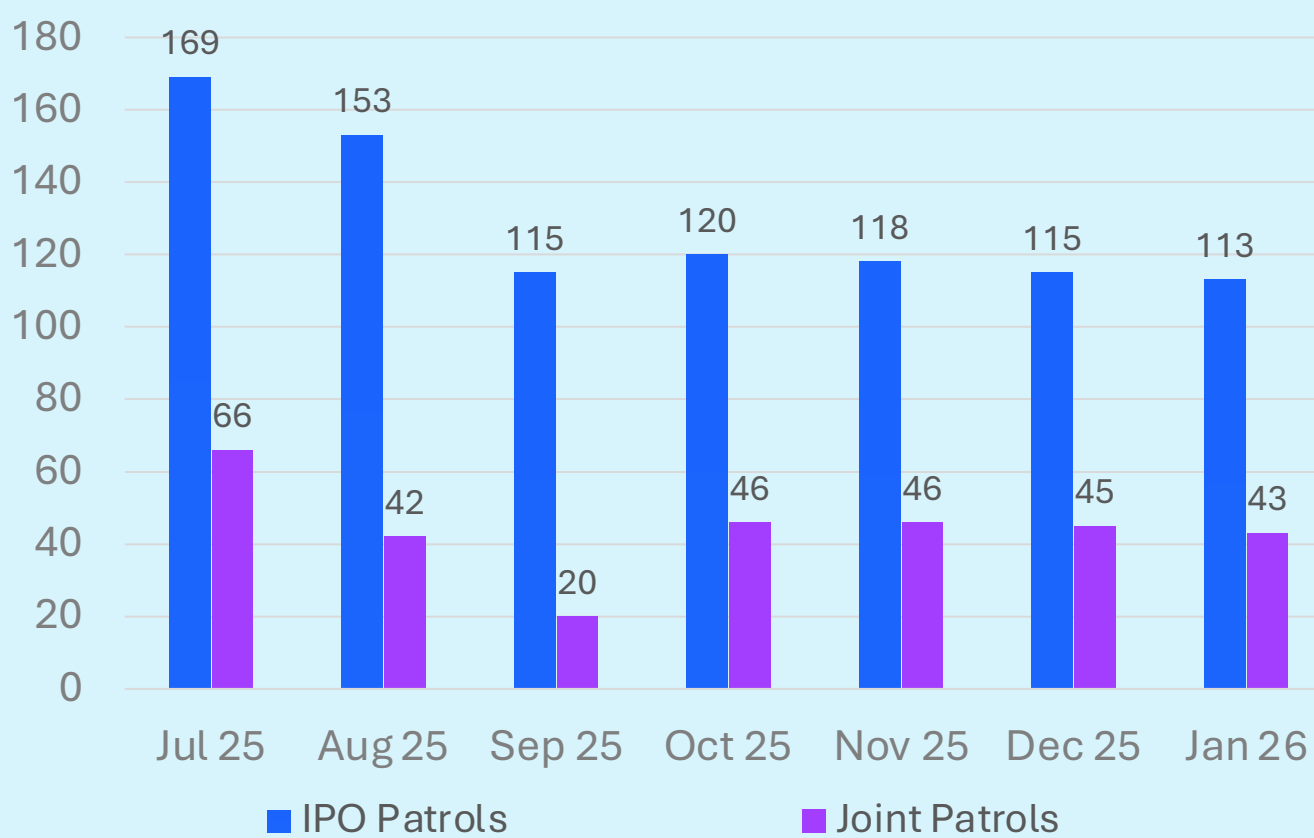

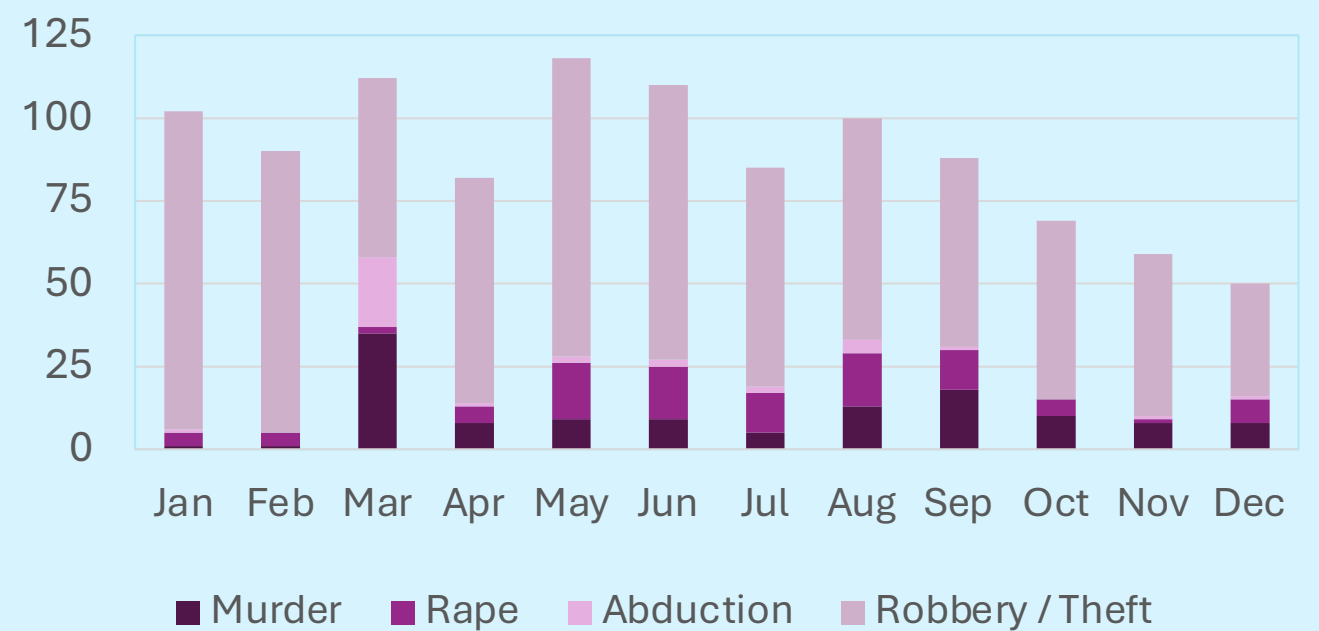

Overall patrols dropped significantly from an average of ~160/month to ~115/month, following the implementation of the contingency plan in September. However Joint Patrolling has been strategically maintained at a stable level to ensure key operational presence.

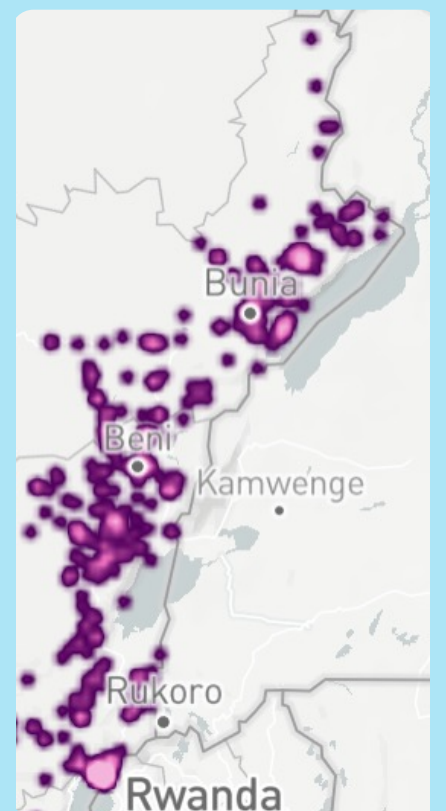


## SOLI-Reported Incidents in N. Kivu and Ituri



The *Stratégie opérationnelle intégrée de lutte contre l'insécurité* (SOLI) is a community-policing initiative for urban areas that combines a public crime-reporting Operations Coordination Centre with targeted training and capacity-building.

- In Beni town, a MONUSCO Formed Police Unit, jointly with the PNC, set up mobile checkpoints in response to increasing criminality in Mulekera commune.
- Individual police officers were redeployed from Goma to Beni, Bunia and Kinshasa, which strengthened the police component's presence in Government-controlled areas
- Increase in joint patrols with the Congolese National Police, visits to internally displaced persons sites and community engagement.

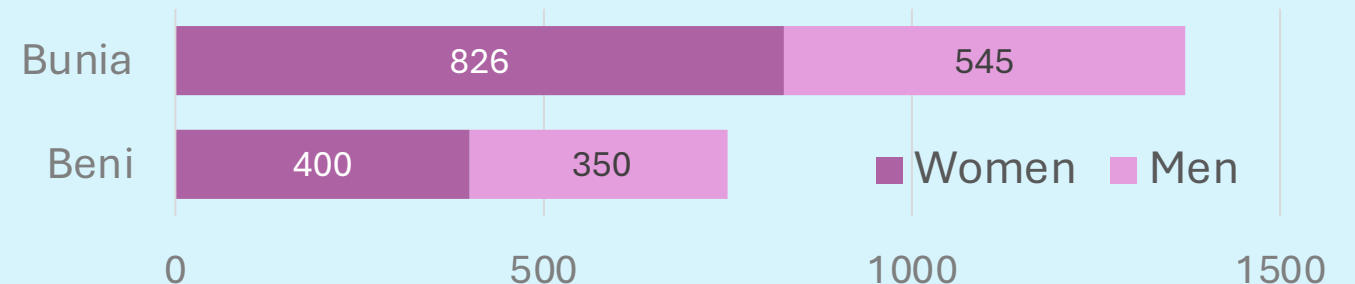

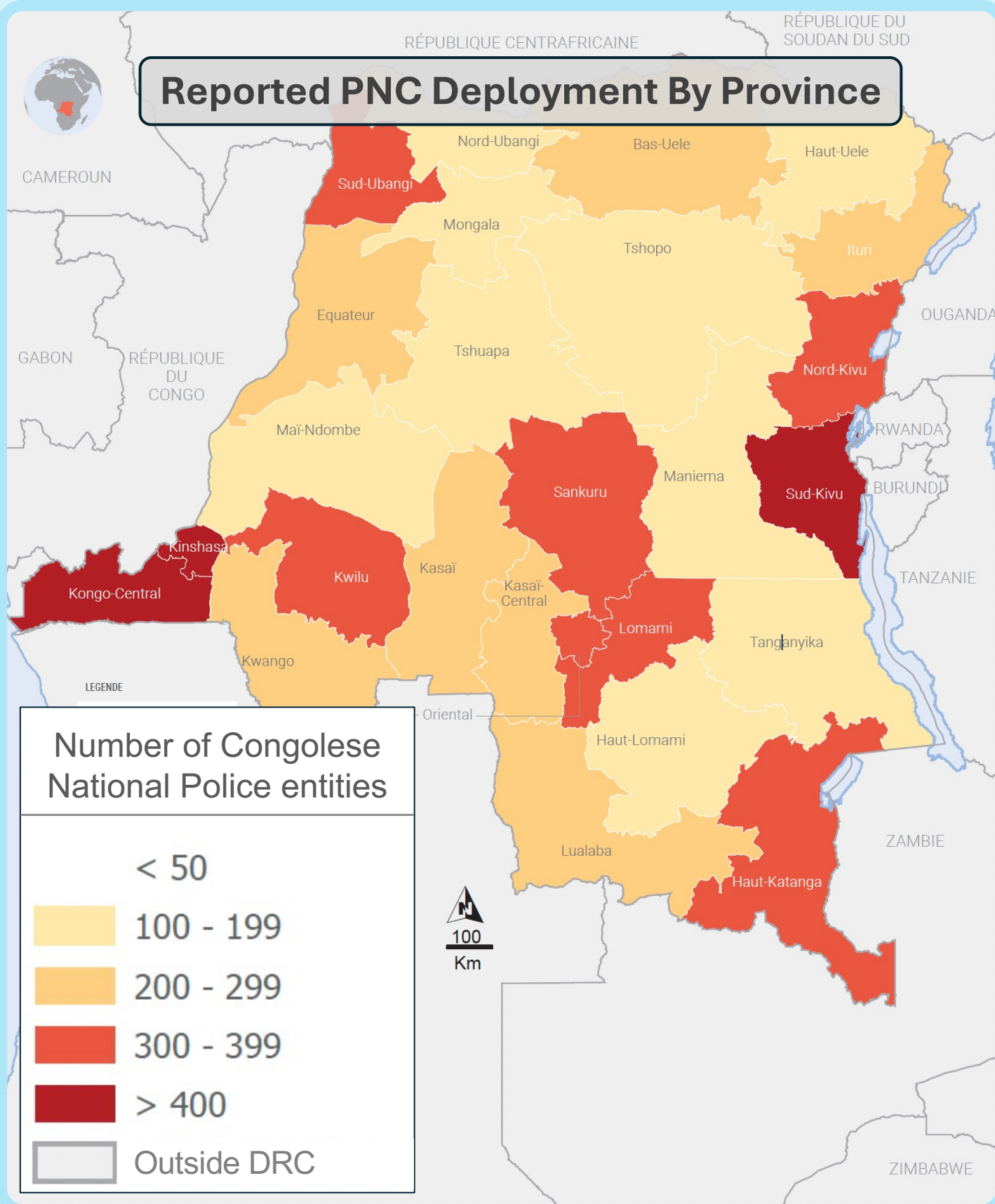
Sensitization sessions are run for men and women from IDP, refugee and host communities, and focus on gender, SGBV and women's rights

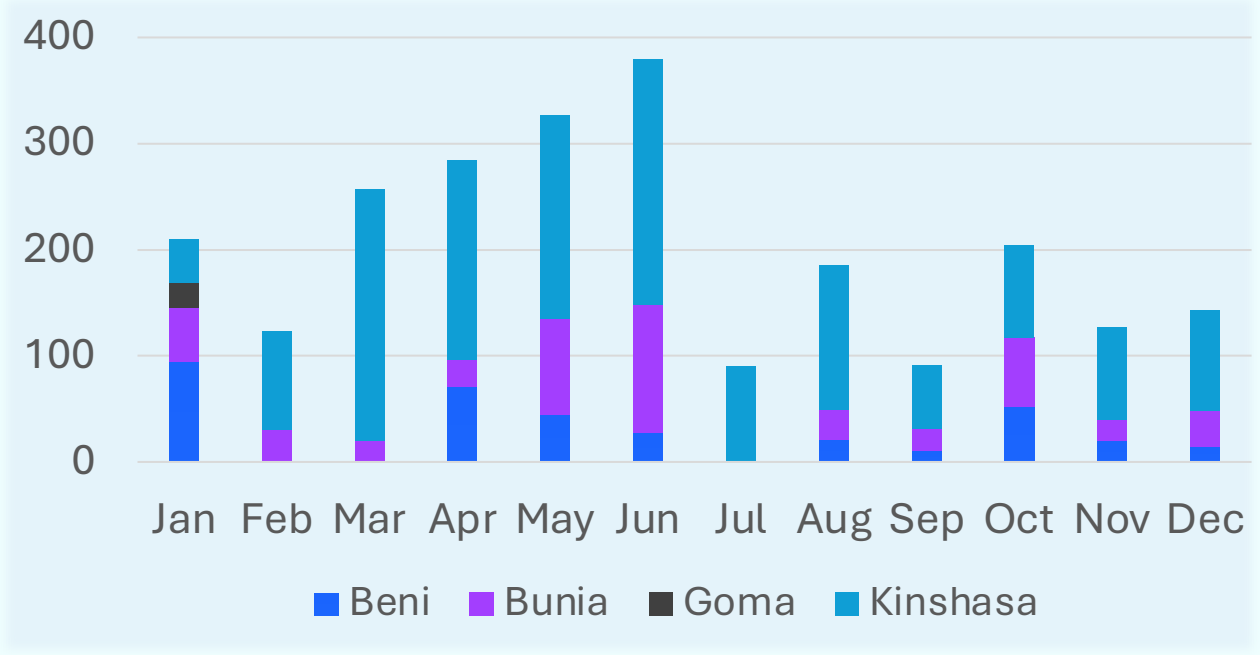

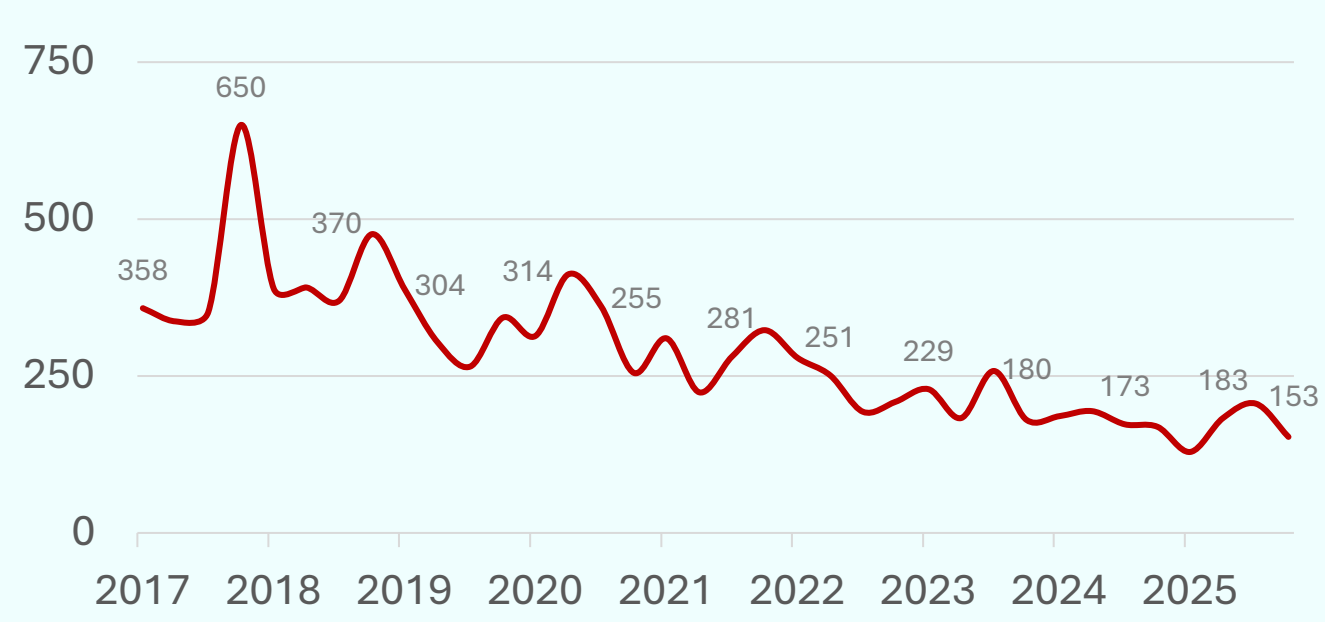

### Monthly Trainings Overview by Location

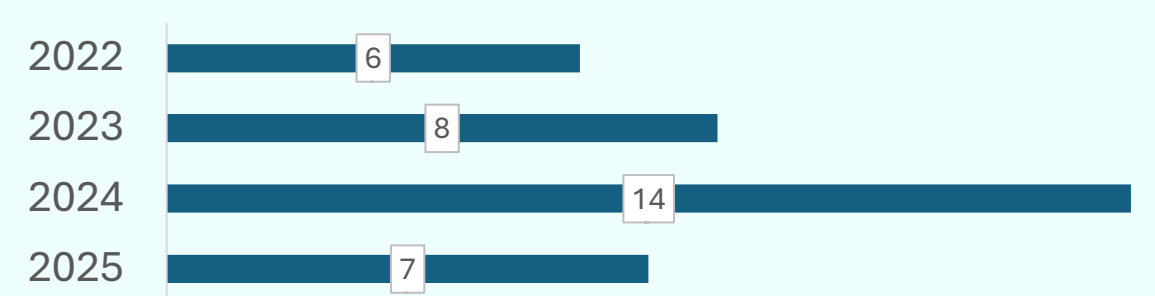
