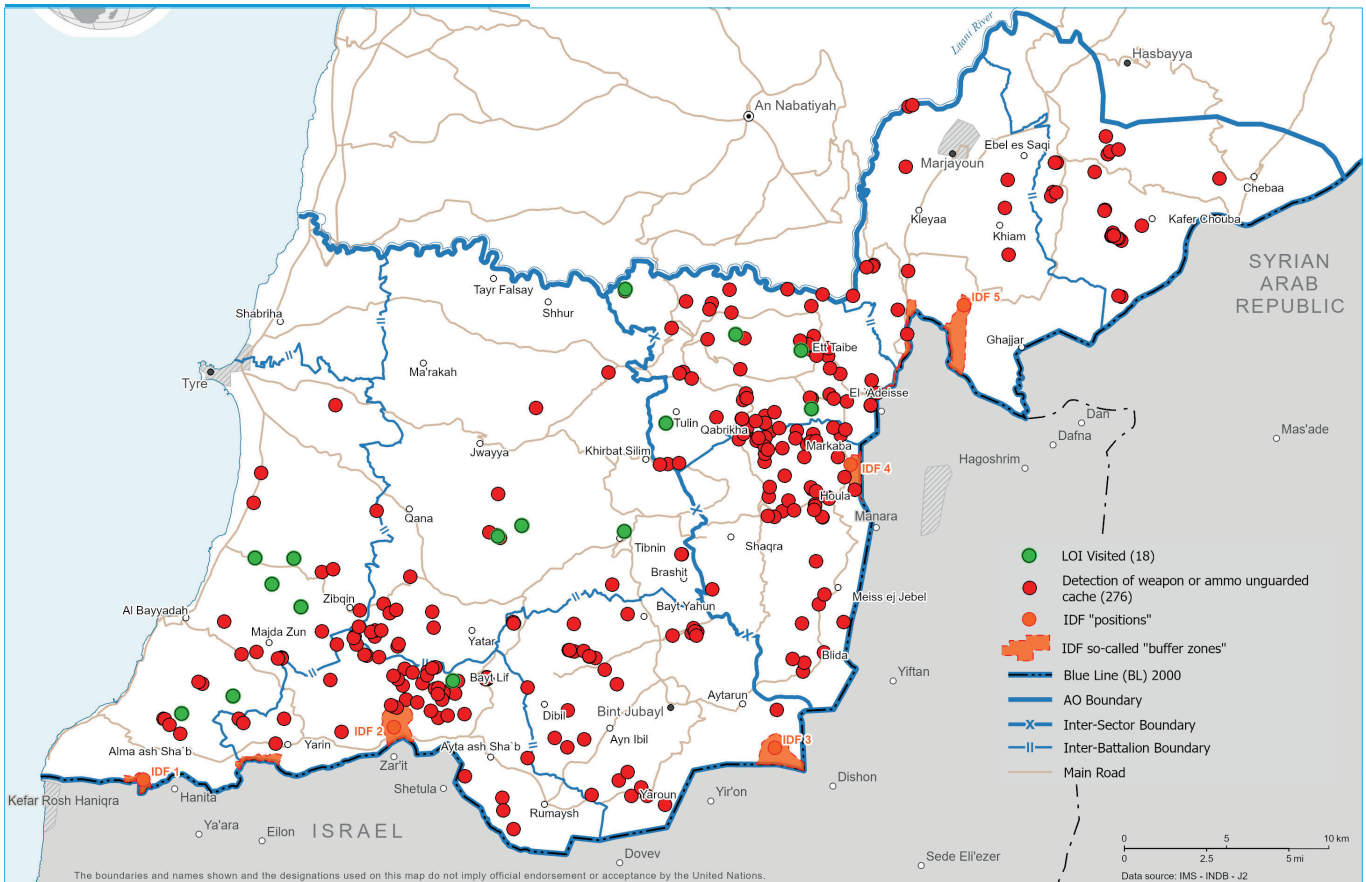




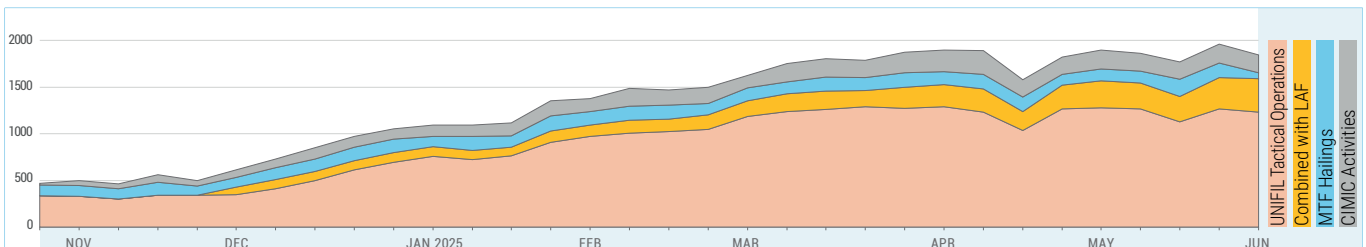
PROACTIVE OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES



UNIFIL has adapted to the new context since the cessation of hostilities. An immediate focus on de-mining and removing roadblocks has provided safe passage for both peacekeepers and communities.

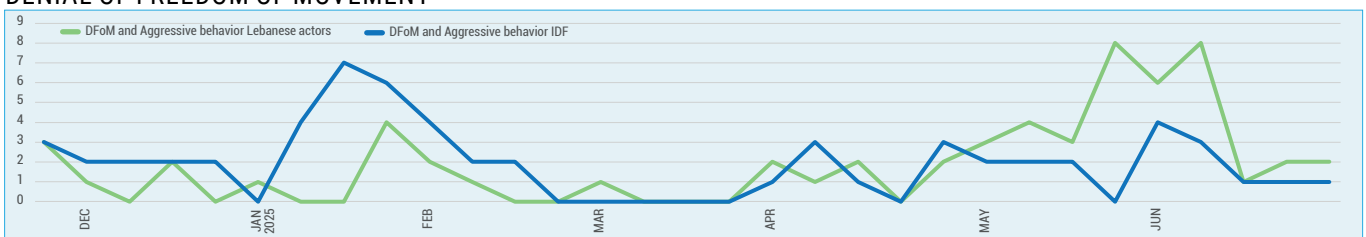
A new operations-led approach has seen 32 operations since March 2025. Each lasts several days and covers specific geographic areas. Operations are coordinated with the LAF with a comprehensive approach including engagement with local authorities and communities. Such adaptation has extended access across the Area of Operations, discovery of weapons caches, strengthened relations with and support to the LAF.

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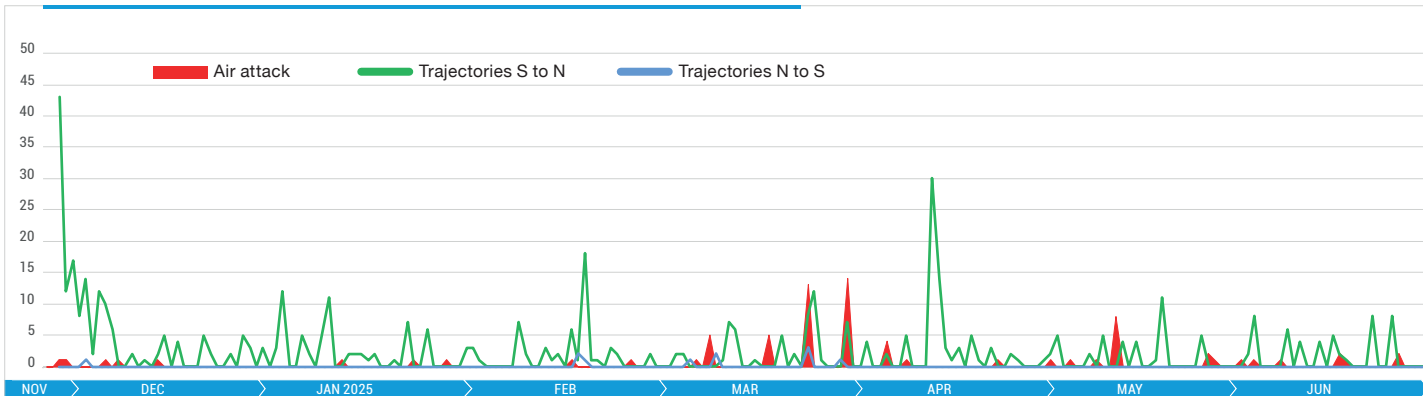


Helicopter patrols increased from under 5/week in January 2025 to over 15 in the final week of June 2025.

DENIAL OF FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT



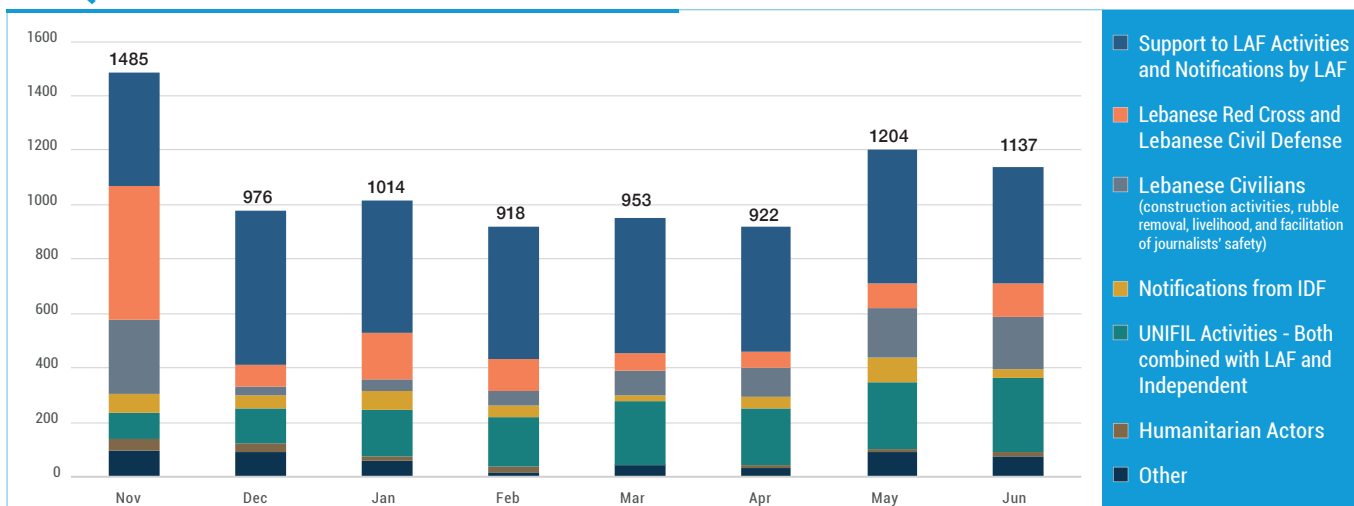
IMPARTIAL MONITORING AND REPORTING



UNIFIL reports to the Security Council on the implementation by the parties and violations of SCR 1701 (2006). Indicators are shared with the parties monthly including violations of the Blue Line which are monitored through observation and radar detection. The Mission continues to work with the parties in seeking to employ more advanced technologies to enhance this capacity.

Previously, during the hostilities between Hizbullah and associated non-state armed groups and the Israel Defence Forces (8 October 2023 to 27 November 2024), UNIFIL reported 54,096 trajectories and 7,881 air violations, including rockets, mortar bombs, and artillery shells, to the UN Security Council.

UNIQUE LIAISON AND COORDINATION



UNIFIL's long-standing liaison and coordination functions play a key role in preventing friction and helping to de-escalate along the Blue Line. Communications channels help ensure safe movement by civilian and humanitarian actors and avoid flashpoints where Israeli and Lebanese forces may come in direct contact with messages passed every day. The Mission has one Liaison team in northern Israel and a long-standing request for an office in Tel Aviv.

Since the cessation of hostilities, UNIFIL has hosted seven meetings of the enhanced "Pentalateral" Mechanism format, initially focused on sequenced planning for re-deployment and withdrawal of LAF and IDF. Previously, through its own Tripartite meetings, the Mission assisted the parties in identifying solutions to many of the disputed points on the Blue Line and maintains unique expertise and capacity to support further progress.
