WHO WE ARE

We are the Jewish Messianic Congregation KJMC Kyiv, serving vulnerable Jewish people and those in need through practical care, humanitarian aid, and spiritual support.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Caring for the elderly is deeply rooted in Jewish tradition. Since the war began in Ukraine, elderly people have become one of the most vulnerable groups in society. Many live alone, suffer from poverty, isolation, power outages, constant shelling, and the trauma of war. Today, our KJMC congregations in Kyiv and Berdychiv care for over 410 elderly Jewish people and vulnerable seniors, many of whom:

- live alone,
- survive on very small pensions,
- experience frequent blackouts,
- and suffer from stress, fear, and loneliness.

We faithfully serve:

- elderly members of our KJMC congregations,
- and Jewish people in need outside the congregation —
- not only with material help, but also with prayer, companionship, and words of hope.

Thanks to donations, we also provide regular assistance to elderly Jewish people in the smaller secular communities of Vasylkiv, Bratslav, and Bohuslav, and we consistently care for 80 secular elderly Jewish people in Kyiv.

Recently, 10 Jewish women in one congregation prayed a prayer of repentance before God. For us, this was a powerful spiritual breakthrough and a great celebration before the Lord. We also partner with a Jewish charitable foundation that prepares hot meals for 500 people in need every month in Kyiv. Among them are not only Jews, but also families of those who once rescued Jews. Sadly, international sponsorship for these categories has nearly stopped, leaving many people on the edge of survival due to war, inflation, and extremely low income.

Today, nearly 1,000 elderly Jewish people and vulnerable individuals need our support. Through your partnership, you can give them not only hot meals and life-saving aid, but also dignity, joy, and hope.
