

Be On The Lookout: Runaway Juveniles from Hammond

HAMMOND (*August 20, 2025*)- The Tangipahoa Parish Sheriff's Office is asking for the public's assistance with locating two runaway juveniles.

Na'kelia Richard, 15, and Greighanah Johnson, 14, were last seen leaving the group home on Patti Road in Hammond on Saturday, August 16.

Na'kelia is described as a black female who has black braided hair with blue braids in the back, brown eyes, standing 5'2" and weighing 124 lbs. She was last seen wearing pink shorts and a pink shirt with blue and white tennis shoes.

Greighanah Johnson is described as a black female with black and blonde braided hair, brown eyes, standing 5'2" and weighing 235 lbs. She was last seen wearing a black sweatshirt with mint green biker tights and pink Croc shoes. Greighanah has a tattoo on her upper right arm that reads 'Ty'reonna.'
