



UPDATE- Suspects Arrested in Business Burglary Investigation

PONCHATOULA (August 20, 2026)- Thanks to tips following our news release on this case, the Tangipahoa Parish Sheriff's Office (TPSO) has identified and arrested the two suspects who burglarized a Ponchatoula-area market.

Travis Gill, 41, and Keith Gill, 46, brothers, were each booked this week on two counts of Simple Burglary and one count of Business Burglary. Keith Gill was also booked on a probation violation while Travis Gill had an additional warrant for Failure to Appear in court.

In the early morning hours of Tuesday, July 21st, TPSO detectives responded to a report of a burglary at a local store located in the 21000 block of Highway 22 in the Ponchatoula area.

Detectives found that the Gill brothers damaged several areas of the building while making attempts to break in, including smashing the glass of the front double doors. The duo got away with multiple items from behind the counter, including cartons of cigarettes.

This investigation also confirmed the Gills' involvement in a previous burglary at this same business.
