
WHAT TO EXPECT

PLEASE NOTE

Our lantern launch is subject to weather conditions which may impact the lanterns movement on the water.

DECORATE YOUR LANTERN

- 1. Decorate your lantern with messages of empowerment, remembrance, and connection.
- 2. Push the four rods into each corner of the lantern base and slide the paper sleeve over the rods
- 3. Place the LED candle in the center of the lantern.
- 4. Listen for instructions and launch your lantern during the designated window.




