10. Are you asking and **expecting** God to change and influence your life? Are you acknowledging the "God-moments"?

- God is always working and creating moments. This will have people see them. Also, I believe part of faith and prayer is not only asking God to move but expecting him to! This might encourage people to make that shift.

11. Do you take time to be still and hear the quiet/simple voice of God?

- To your point, sometimes God does have simple commands for us to listen to and follow. Oftentimes God does move in subtle ways and we must take time to be quiet and still to notice. This will help people see if they really do that.

12. What is keeping you from accepting God's unconditional love for you? Even a disciple turned away from Jesus for a time, yet God still loved and used him for His glory. You are not too far gone... ever.

- What I don't think people realize is that not believing God could love you unconditionally doesn't put you down, it puts God down. What you're really saying is "God, you're not big enough." Do you really think God is capable of anything and everything except loving you in your mistakes (moments of learning)?

13. Do you know God in your heart or just in your mind? What does this look like for you?

- Many kids my age know what or who God is supposed to be but still don't live for him. God does want out true friendship and devotion. This will cause thought.

14. Have you surrendered your future to God? How can you do that?

- This is something everyone struggles with. We often want to take life into our own hands vs. admit that it is completely unknown.

15. Are you open to letting God use you in His plan? Even if your life doesn't end up looking like you thought it would?

- I believe most people want God to work in and through their life but inside the plan they created for themselves not necessarily the one He has for them. This step takes taking up your cross daily and making a conscious decision to follow him in every moment.
