Question 1: Your answers to life’s biggest questions....

In chapter 2, we list some of life’s biggest questions about our Origin, Purpose, Destiny,Truth, Morality and Authority. **How we answer these “worldview” questions ...describes the way we look at and explain life and the world around us. It influences what we regard as truth.**

 **Origin:** How did you get here? What value is there in your life? Value to who? Why?

Purpose: Why are you here? What is life’s meaning? Is that important to you? Why?

Destiny: Where are you going? Is there a future afterlife? Can you describe it?

Truth: Would you want to live by objective truth or subjective truth? Why?

(Objective truth refers to facts or realities that exist independently of individual beliefs or perceptions.)

(Subjective truth is based on someone’s feelings, desires or standards that fit the time and place.)

Morality: Should moral standards be based on objective or subjective truth? Why?

(Morality — issues about what is right and what is wrong — is based either on an objective set of moral standards, or subjectively based on someone’s feeling, desires or standards that fit the time and place.)

Authority: Do you believe in the existence of a supreme being? Why? Describe “Him”?

Question 2: How are you setting “Life Boundaries” for yourself?


In Chapter 3, we discuss setting Life Boundaries, so we grow in the Lord and are strong and vigorous in His TRUTH. God’s Word instructs us...

Question 3: TELL ME YOUR STORY about your life's foundation

In Chapter 6, we compare building our lives on a solid foundation to seeing major structures like the Empire State Building **still standing after years of storms**, ...because **their foundation goes down to bedrock**. Such comparison is made by Jesus in Matthew 7:24-25 NLT....

"Anyone who listens to My teaching (*TRUTHS*) and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house (*THEIR LIFE*) on solid rock. Though the rain (*DIFFICULTIES*) comes in torrents and the floodwaters (*SORROWS*) rise and the winds (*SPIRITUAL BATTLES*) beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock (*RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD*)."

— Matthew 7:24-25

Jesus is THE bedrock TRUTH we build our lives on....
