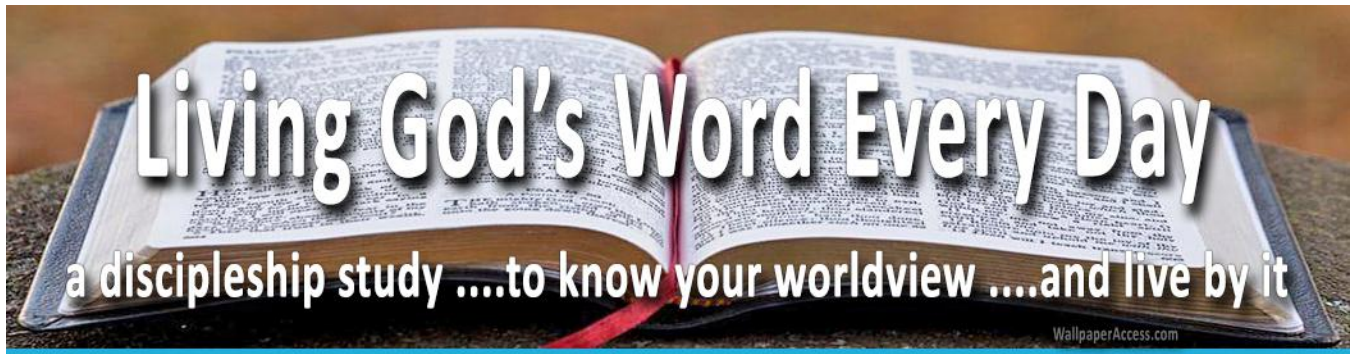




Know your foundation....

God’s “gift of learning” to know Him

From the day you received Jesus as your Savior and Lord,the Holy Spirit began helping you build and nurture your worldview to **THINK and BE like Jesus.**

You are **living a brand-new kind of life that is continually learning** more and more of what is right, and trying constantly to **be more and more like Christ who created this new life within you.** — Colossians 3:10 TLB

Question 1: How are you setting “Life Boundaries” for yourself?

In Chapter 3, we discuss **God’s “gift of learning” TO KNOW HIM**. In the flow of conversation, we talk about setting “live-by-truth” LIFE BOUNDARIES for yourself, so you grow in the Lord and are strong and vigorous in His TRUTH. God’s Word instructs us....

We have cause to celebrate because **THE GRACE OF GOD HAS APPEARED, offering the gift of salvation to all people. GRACE ARRIVES WITH ITS OWN INSTRUCTION: run away from anything that leads us away from God; abandon the lusts and passions of this world; live life now in this age WITH AWARENESS AND SELF-CONTROL, doing the right thing and keeping yourselves holy.** — Titus 2:11-12 The Voice

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Question 3: TELL ME YOUR STORY about your life’s foundation

In Chapter 6, we compare building our lives on a solid foundation to seeing major structures like the Empire State Building **still standing after years of storms**,because **their foundation goes down to bedrock**. Such comparison is made by Jesus in Matthew 7:24-25 NLT....

"Anyone who listens to MY TEACHING and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house **(THEIR LIFE) on solid rock**. Though the rain (*TRIALS, DIFFICULTIES*) comes in torrents and the floodwaters (*SORROWS*) rise and the winds (*SPIRITUAL BATTLES*) beat against that house, it won't collapse because **it is built on bedrock (RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD).**"

— Matthew 7:24-25 NLT

Then in John 14:19-20 NLT, we learn....



Jesus is THE bedrock TRUTH we build our lives on....

- "Since I live, you also will live"with Me in Heaven for ETERNITY!
- "When I am raised to life again, you will know"the TRUTH!
- "You are in Me, and I am in you"NOW as we do life together!
