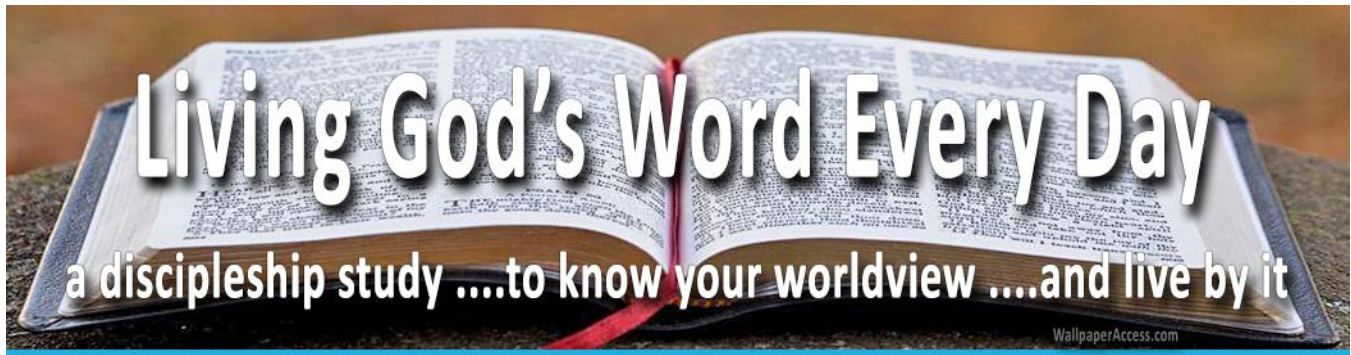




How to build a Biblical Worldview....

Go to website ***KnowYourWorldview.org*** and read **Chapters 16 – 17**. Notice the peace Jesus gives us,when we rest in Himand prepare ourselves to win spiritual battles with God’s help,as we “put on every piece of God’s armor”.

- **LIVE DAILY** in the peace Jesus gives,remembering what He told us
- **KEEP OUR FOCUS** on Heaven’s reality,our eternal home
- **PREPARE FOR SPIRITUAL BATTLES** by putting on **ALL** of God’s armor – Ephesians 6:13-18

....because....

You are living a brand new kind of life that is CONTINUALLY LEARNING more and more of what is right, and TRYING CONSTANTLY TO BE MORE AND MORE LIKE CHRIST who created this new life within you. — Colossians 3:10 TLB

Let’s talk about it...

Question 1: What does it mean“*LIVING IN JESUS’ PEACE is how we handle daily challenges*”? How is it possible for us to do that?

In chapter 16, we discuss the amazing peace of Jesus Christ. As He said in John 14:27-28,

"I am leaving you with a gift — peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid. REMEMBER WHAT I TOLD YOU...."

A Max Lucado quote gives us THE answer to above questions about living in Jesus' peace — **"Paul wrote, 'Let the peace that Christ gives control your thinking....' How does this happen? The answer appears in the next verse: 'Let the word of God dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another....'" (see Colossians 3:15 NCV & 16 NKJV)**



Restate Max's quote, explaining to yourselfhow to live in each day's challenges and choices.

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Why did Jesus say "Remember what I told you"?



Chapter 16 discusses God's plan for us to be with Him in Heaven for Eternity. How does remembering — "...THROUGH YOUR FAITH, GOD IS PROTECTING YOU BY HIS POWER" *until you get to Heaven (1 Peter 1:3-5 NLT)* — influence your living daily in the peace Jesus gives you?

Question 2: What is God’s plan for you to learn how to build a Biblical worldviewthat wins spiritual battleswith His help?

In Chapter 17, God outlines construction plans for you to follow, as **you answer questions 1-9 on the following pages**. God is telling youALL you need to know for a strong worldview.

First, God tell us **WHY? we need a Biblical worldview**,so we can defeat spiritual attacks....

A final word: **Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power**. Put on all of God’s armor so that **you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil**. For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places.

— Ephesians 6:10-12 NLT

Then, God gives detailed steps on **our responsibility to prepare ourselves for spiritual battles**

Therefore, **put on every piece of God’s armor (1. ACTIVELY ENGAGE)** so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm.

Stand your ground (2. NOT RUN IN FEAR), putting on the belt of truth **(3. LIVE WITH INTEGRITY)** and the body armor of God’s righteousness **(4. LIVE FOR GOD’S APPROVAL)**. For shoes, **put on the peace that comes from the Good News (5. LIVE IN THE PEACE JESUS GIVES, chapter 16)** so that you will be fully prepared.



In addition to all of these, **hold up the shield of faith (6. PROTECT YOUR HEART)** to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. **Put on salvation as your helmet (7. PROTECT YOUR MIND)**, and **take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God (8. GAIN KNOWLEDGE OF GODTO PROTECT YOUR GOD-FOCUSED WORLDVIEW)**.

Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert**be persistent in your prayers.... (9. ALWAYS STAY CONNECTED WITH GOD’S PRESENCE)**.

— Ephesians 6:13-18 NLT

4 How do you put on “the body armor of God’s righteousness” to LIVE FOR GOD’S APPROVAL? Ponder Philippians 2:13 and 1 John 2:17.



5 Describe how you “put on the peace that comes from the Good News” to LIVE IN THE PEACE JESUS GIVES? Consider Philippians 4:6-7 and 2 Peter 1:2.

Contemplate John 14:27, Romans 8:6, and Philippians 4:7.

-  **8** Explain what it means to “take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God” to GAIN KNOWLEDGE OF GODTO PROTECT YOUR GOD-FOCUSED WORLDVIEW?
See Psalm 119:9-16 and Philippians 4:8-9.

-  **9** Why should you “pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion” to ALWAYS STAY CONNECTED WITH GOD’S PRESENCE? Read Psalm 119:10-12 and Psalm 27:8
