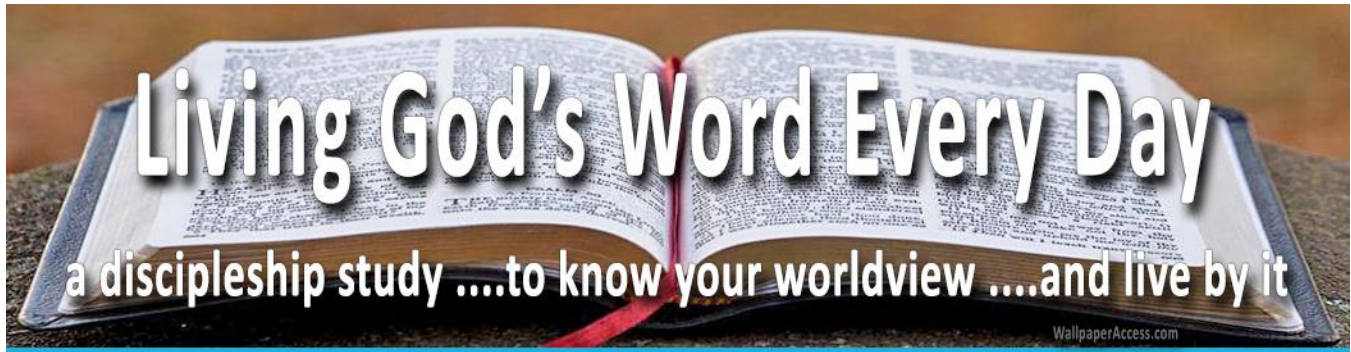




Jesus IS the Way, the Truth, and the Life

Why did Jesus say....

"I am the WAY, the TRUTH, and the LIFE. No one can come to the Father except through Me."
— John 14:6 NLT

Because....



- We were lost,so God shows us the **WAY** to find Him.
- We don't know eternal truth,unless God tells us **TRUTH**.
- We are spiritually dead in sin,until God gives us **New LIFE**.

Jesus' mission is necessary,obvious we need His help....

Jesus' Mission

If Jesus is "the WAY, the TRUTH, and the LIFE",then we should look for, even expect "God-Moments" in our lives, when He **SHOWS US THE WAY**,**TELLS US THE TRUTH**,and **REVEALS HIS PRESENCE IN OUR LIVES**.

These are the consequences of being actively engaged in life with Jesus,

....AS WE EXPERIENCE KNOWING GOD.

Let's talk about it...

Question 1: Why is Jesus “the WAY”, “the TRUTH”, and the “Life”?

In Chapter 8.2, we discuss: **Why is Jesus the “ONLY WAY” for our salvation, saying.... “No one can come to the Father except through me”?** Answers express our worldview about **Truth** and **Morality**,and Who God IS to each one of us.

There are a lot of voices in life wanting our attention — some good, some not so good. YOU HAVE TO DECIDE WHAT IS TRUTH AND WHAT IS NOT. Because "what" you believe influences the choices you make in life.

This maze image **illustrates our journey through life >>>**through what is often a complex mixture of choiceson our journey from “Today”to “the rest of Eternity”.



Taking the red path making “decisive” choicesrepresents us being guided by the Holy Spiritas we face life’s choices.



Open **BlueLetterBible.com** website and (using A-B-C-D search steps from Journal 1) enter John 14:6. Search original meanings for words “Way”, “Truth”, and “Life”. Review a few commentaries for more understanding.

 **Jesus is “the ONLY Way” (G3598) to “What?” Why should you follow Him?**

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 **Jesus is “the ONLY Truth” (G225) about “What?” Why should we believe Him?**

 **Why is Jesus “the ONLY Life” (G2222)?” for “What?” Why should we want what He offers?**

Question 2: Why is Jesus worthy of our praise and worship?

In Chapter 8.3, we discuss **Jesus perfectly completing God’s Counterintuitive Plan** (see chapter 8) for our salvation through His life, death, and resurrection, ...ransoming us from sin and death. **Jesus did everything He came to do for us who believe.** See Philippians 2:6-11 online.



Why is it important that Jesus perfectly completed God’s Counterintuitive Plan?



Why does Jesus offer us New Life with Himself? Why should we be Born Again?

The abundant life Jesus givesis not about material possessions or accomplishments; it is about **knowing** God, **being** in Him, **bearing** the fruit of the Holy Spirit, and **manifesting** the gifts of the Holy Spirit for the glory of God. **(See online Eph 3:16-19; Gal 5:22-23; 1 Cor 12:4-11.)**

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Question 3: TELL ME YOUR STORY about Who Jesus IS to you

The following summary questions express the core foundation of your Biblical worldview. Look back over your previous journals, and **keep building your story**. And tell others about it.



 **Why do you follow Jesus? Who is He to you?Why is Jesus worthy of all you are, and of dedicating your life and giftings for His glory?**



“Living God’s Word Every Day” is a discipleship study to think and write about your worldview. Writing is a processing step to express personal beliefs and values for making choices in life. Ask a friend or study group to “challenge you” as a safe-space to learn how to tell your story about “Why?” you believe “What?” about life with Jesus as Savior, Lord, and Friend. **Acts 1:8**
