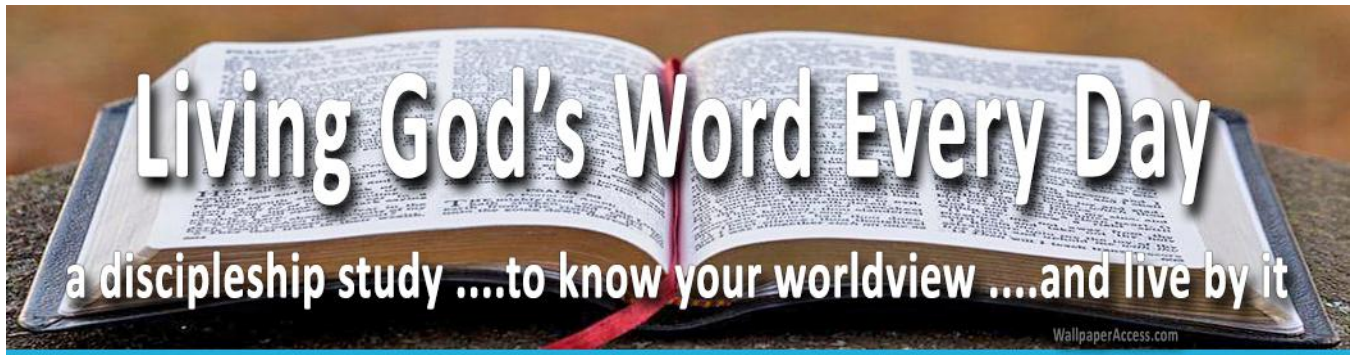




Know “How?” to study your Bible....

Have you ever wondered what makes God smile?

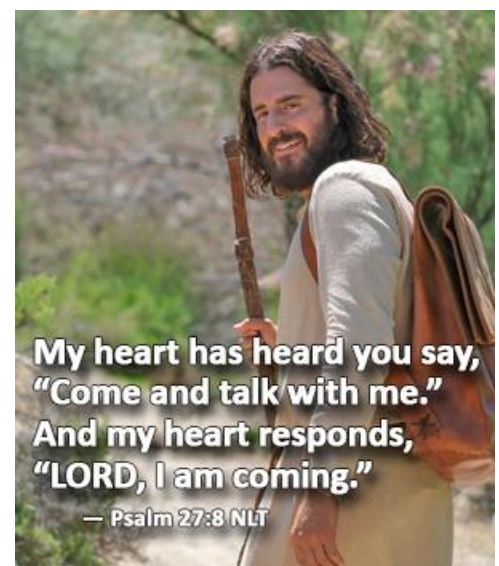

Question 1: How do we RELATE to God’s TRUTHS in His Word?

In chapter 20, we discuss our “3Rs + Prayer” Bible study approachand “how we RELATE to God’s Word”. Previously in Journal 7, we discussed Step 1: “SEE Truth as you READ” God’s Word.

Now in **Step 2: “BELIEVE as you RELATE”**, the question iswhat will you do about relating God’s TRUTH to your life’s circumstances?



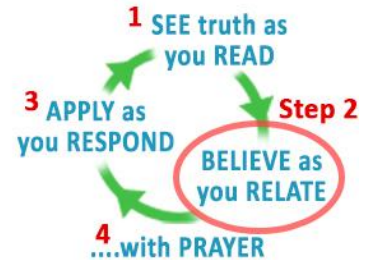
Let’s recall our discussion in the online Introduction about Bloom’s Taxonomyand how it relates to God’s “gift of learning” to know Him.

To build a Biblical worldview, we must first **KNOW JESUS**,then **cultivate a learning, believing mind and desire a teachable, responding heart.**

Let’s dig into **God’s “gift of learning”** and answer questions about those 6 steps: REMEMBER, UNDERSTAND, APPLY, ANALYZE, EVALUATE, and CREATEas we build our worldview knowledge of Romans 12:2. Use this MSG version, or select your preferred translation at **BibleGateway.com**



“Read > Relate > Respond” Bible Study Approach



Don’t become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, **fix your attention on God. YOU’LL BE CHANGED FROM THE INSIDE OUT. Readily RECOGNIZE WHAT HE WANTS from you, and quickly RESPOND TO IT.** Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity,**GOD BRINGS THE BEST OUT OF YOU, DEVELOPS WELL-FORMED MATURITY IN YOU.** — Romans 12:2 MSG

-  **1** **REMEMBER** scripture you’ve thought about and learned,see Psalm 119:11. Meditate on Romans 12:2and **identify what details you need to REMEMBER.**

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-  **2** **UNDERSTAND** the benefits of what you’ve learned,see Psalm 119:105. Ponder Romans 12:2and **explain what knowledge you UNDERSTAND from God’s Word.**

-  **3 APPLY** “knowledge of God” learned into your life’s circumstances,see 2 Peter 1:3-8.
Consider Romans 12:2and **describe what is relevant that you will APPLY in your life.**

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-  **4 ANALYZE** outcomes of your worldview choices in life,see Romans 12:2.
Scrutinize your life choices with Romans 12:2and **detail any issues you should resolve.**

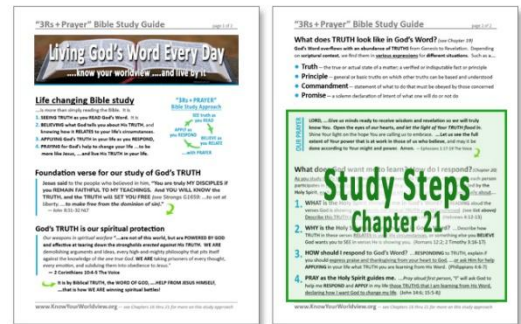
-  **5 EVALUATE** “God’s TRUTH” in your worldview choices,see Philippians 4:8-9.
Critique your life’s choices with Romans 12:2,**describe the results of your appraisal.**

-  **6 CREATE** the reality of God’s Word into your life’s story,see Colossians 3:10.
Outline steps to continue building your Biblical worldview using principles learned.

Let’s begin group study with Our Prayer....

OUR PRAYER

LORD,Give us minds ready to receive wisdom and revelation so we will truly know You. Open the eyes of our hearts, and let the light of Your TRUTH flood in. Shine Your light on the hope You are calling us to embrace.Let us see the FULL EXTENT of YOUR POWER that is AT WORK IN THOSE OF US WHO BELIEVE, and may it be done according to Your might and power. Amen. — Ephesians 1:17-19 The Voice



Today, our small group is reading **Matthew chapter 19**. Each person shares in reading aloud the Bible chapter we are studying today, as we read through the Bible, chapter-by-chapter. Then, as led by the Holy Spirit, each person shares what TRUTH they “SEE” in scripturefollowing these 4 steps:

1. WHAT is the Holy Spirit helping me “SEE” in God's Word?

From Matthew 19:1-9, READ aloud the verses God is showing you, identifying what Biblical TRUTH you “SEE” expressed. Is that TRUTH a Truth, Principle, Commandment, or a Promise?

Describe the TRUTH you “SEE” in Biblical context. What is happening here?

2. WHY is the Holy Spirit showing me this TRUTH in God's Word?



Describe how Biblical TRUTH in these verses RELATES to your life's circumstances, or perhaps something else you BELIEVE God wants you to SEE in verses the Holy Spirit is showing you.

3. HOW should I “RESPOND” to God's Word?



RESPONDING to God’s TRUTH, explain to your group if you should express thanksgiving and praise from your heart to God,or ask Him for help APPLYING in your life what TRUTH you are learning from His Word. Describe what you believe God wants you to do about it?

4. PRAY for God’s help as the Holy Spirit guides me.



Knowing you want to APPLY in your life those TRUTHS you are learning from God's Word, pray aloud in the first person ("I, me, my")asking God for help RESPONDING to His TRUTH in your life. Your friends could join you in prayer, as they are led by the Holy Spirit.

Write your prayer....

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“Living God’s Word Every Day” is a discipleship study to think and write about your worldview. Writing is a processing step to express personal beliefs and values for making choices in life. Ask a friend or study group to “challenge you” as a safe-space to learn how to tell your story about “Why?” you believe “What?” about life with Jesus as Savior, Lord, and Friend. **Acts 1:8**
