

INFORMATION CLAUSE ON PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

BY TRIGON DOM MAKLEPSKI SA

1. The Administrator of your personal data is Trigon Dom Maklerski Spółka Akcyjna, ul. Mogilska 65, 31-545 Kraków, KRS: 0000033118, NIP: 676-10-44-221, REGON: 001270919.
2. To ensure the safe and correct processing of your data we have appointed a **Data Protection Officer**. For any inquiries, please contact us at: dpo@trigon.pl.
3. We process the data in order to keep the Register of Shareholders on the basis of signed contract with the company in which you are a shareholder and applicable law, including the Act of September 15, 2000 – Code of Commercial Companies (Article 6 (1) (b) and (c) GDPR).
4. We process the data in the following areas: information about the company, information about shares, identification data of shareholders or other entities disclosed in the Register of Shareholders, address and contact details.
5. The recipients of your data are only entities authorized to obtain them on the basis of generally applicable law, including other shareholders of the company.
6. Data which we process, we obtain directly from you or from the company in which you are shareholder.
7. You may refuse to provide your personal data, however it will result in inability to disclose yourself in the Register of Shareholders
8. In connection with the processing of data by Trigon Dom Maklerski Spółka Akcyjna **you have the following rights:**
 - The right to access your own data, revise, transfer and/or delete them;
 - Restriction of processing, to raise an objection and “being forgotten”;
 - Withdraw consent from the processing, if such a consent has been provided;

The exercise of your rights may be limited, if separate provisions oblige us to do so. Nevertheless, each of your requests will be treated by Trigon Dom Maklerski Spółka Akcyjna individually and with due attention.

9. We will process your data for the period of keeping by Trigon Dom Maklerski Spółka Akcyjna the Register of Shareholders.
10. If you believe that we are processing your data unlawfully, you may submit a complaint to the Personal Data Protection Office, however we encourage you to contact our Data Protection Officer in advance.
11. We do not transfer your personal data to third countries.
12. We do not process your data in an automated manner, nor do we perform profiling.
