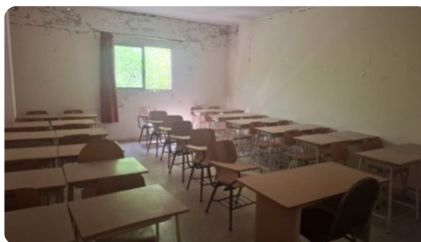

Resuming education in Lebanon: Super Novae launches its first education initiative in Lebanon

Bringing classrooms back to life

For too long, conflict, displacement and insecurity have kept classrooms empty and interrupted the education of children across **Lebanon**. For displaced children in particular, months away from school have meant not only lost learning, but also the loss of routine, stability and a safe place to connect with others.

Today, those classrooms are coming back to life!

With the financial support of **Frontlines for Peace**, and in close partnership with **Lebanon's Ministry of Education and Higher Education (MEHE)**, Super Novae has launched its first activity in Lebanon at the Hrar Teachers Learning Hub in Akkar. The initiative contributes to MEHE's harmonised education recovery plan and supports the Ministry's official Summer Teaching and Learning Hub Programme.

The Hrar hub now welcomes up to 110 conflict-affected children across four classes for Grades 4 to 7, supported by five MEHE-appointed teachers.

Over six weeks, children are reconnecting with **Arabic, foreign-language learning, mathematics and science**, while also participating in **social-emotional learning, recreational activities and psychosocial support**.

This recovery programme is about much more than catching up academically. It gives children the opportunity to rebuild routines, confidence and a sense of normality before the beginning of

the 2026–2027 school year. Where classrooms had remained silent for too long, there are now lessons, conversations, games and children learning together again.

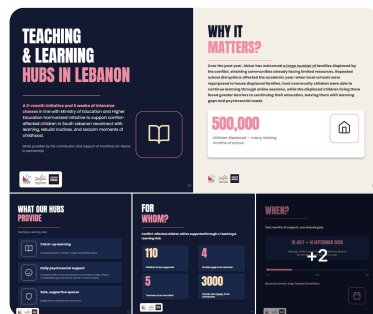
The project is also supporting the hub with educational and recreational materials, operational assistance and improvements to the learning environment. Planned investments include student desks, projectors and screens, and fans.

These improvements will remain with **MEHE**, allowing the facility to continue benefiting children, teachers and the surrounding community after the summer programme ends.

This first intervention represents an important milestone for Super Novae in Lebanon. It demonstrates what can be achieved when national leadership, operational expertise and committed donor support come together.



We look forward to sharing more stories from the children, teachers and team bringing the Hrar Teaching and Learning Hub back to life.
