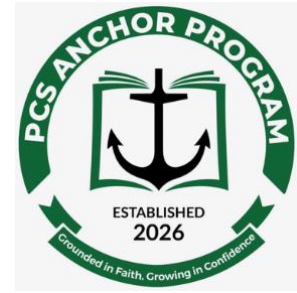


## Grounded in Faith Growing in Confidence
