




Our nationwide search for Upper School Principal has begun. We are working with a local HR firm to facilitate the search. As I prepare for candidate interviews, I have targeted a select group of 29 individuals representing a broad swath of PCS stakeholders to provide a list of competencies they would like to see in our next leader.

These same individuals have been invited to serve on a team panel to meet each of the final three candidates on Saturday, April 18th. This team will have an opportunity to meet and interact with the final candidates and provide meaningful input. The composition of this team is noted on the graphic below.

“As the United States celebrates 250 years as a nation this July, we are reminded of great men and women who have influenced our history and shaped its culture. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. is an example of someone who stood against injustice and strived to bring unity and racial reconciliation. In his short 39 years of life, King traveled over six million miles speaking over 2,500 times. He wrote five books and numerous articles, including his [Letter from Birmingham Jail](#), and delivered his famous [I Have a Dream](#) speech.”

“At age 18, he wrote an article called [The Purpose of Education](#) for the campus newspaper at Morehouse College. King reminded readers that ‘We must remember that intelligence is not enough. Intelligence plus character—that is the goal of true education.’ Together, let’s continue to be and to build ambassadors for Jesus Christ. Let’s remain committed to reconciliation with God and to one another as we prioritize discipleship and community in Christ.” – Dr. Larry Taylor, President, ACSI
