



6th - 8th Grade 2026-2027 Supply List

Label all your items: First and last name on school supplies, all uniform garments, outerwear, Bibles, lunch boxes, headphones, pencil pouches, folders, spirals, gym clothes, and water bottles.

NIV Bible, not a journaling style. 2011 Edition preferred.

Red, blue, and black ink pens

Pencils

Large eraser

Colored pencils, sharpened

Pencil pouch

Graph paper

Standard ruler to stay at home

3 packs of loose leaf notebook paper, wide or college ruled, your choice

Pocket and Prong plastic folders, assorted colors, at least 6

Spiral notebooks, 1 subject, assorted colors, thinner types about 70 pages, at least 6

Headphones -NO WIRELESS, **WIRED ONLY** earphones for Chromebook usage

Completely transparent, plastic water bottle with screw on lid, no straw tops or squeeze tops. **ALL OTHER WATER BOTTLES ARE PROHIBITED.**

All Girls: give to first period teacher

Box of disinfecting wipes

Box of tissues

100 index cards (lined)

1 box of dry erase markers

All Boys: give to first period teacher

Bottle of hand sanitizer

Box of tissues

100 index cards (lined)

1 box of dry erase

Optional:

Any locker decorations must be magnetic only. Ex. mirrors, pencil holders, etc. NO ADHESIVE. Locker organization products such as shelves (you may want to measure your locker before purchasing shelving)

Backpack or satchel to carry items home, no rolling backpacks unless per physician

Strongly recommended for all 6th and 7th graders. It is optional for 8th grade students, but is a useful resource for any student who struggles with organizing their school handouts and homework papers, as everything is neat and in one location. They will carry this to each classroom daily.

Examples:

**Course specific items:**Math:

- 4 function (+, -, X, divide) calculator with square root and memory keys, only to be used with teacher approval on certain assignments
- For Algebra One only: 2.5 inch binder
