Our lantern launch is subject to weather conditions which may impact the lanterns movement on the water.

DECORATE YOUR LANTERN

1. Decorate your lantern with messages of empowerment, remembrance, and connection.
2. Push the four rods into each corner of the lantern base and slide the paper sleeve over the rods
3. Place the LED candle in the center of the lantern.
4. Listen for instructions and launch your lantern during the designated window.

ROSY L.

Rosy L. is a Laotian singer-songwriter based in Dallas, TX. She is known for her smooth vocals, and the healing aspect of her lyrics that are focused on mental health, accompanied by her acoustic or electric guitar. Laos is a small land-locked country in Southeast Asia, so Rosy also enjoys sharing her Lao culture with her listeners by incorporating Lao lyrics into her songs.



DEER FELLOW

Austin-based duo Deer Fellow serves up cozy indie folk-pop with “comforting yet bold musicality.” Matt Salois (vocals, electric guitar, looping, percussion) and Alyssa Kelly (vocals, violin, keys) have built a cross-genre sound that “stirs hearts with each carefully crafted note.” “It’s hard to tell where the duo behind Deer Fellow ends and the other begins. Matt and Alyssa’s voices, like instruments, interchange, blend, rise and fall in ways

that few duos can achieve. If listeners are lucky enough to catch a live show, they’d be forgiven for mistaking the pair for a full band upon first note. Matt’s guitar looping techniques, skillful chord progressions, and percussive elements, along with Alyssa’s synth backgrounds and bell-clear violin, produce a fulsome sound that is far from the typical duo most listeners have come to expect.” – EASTside Magazine. The two's intricate vocal harmonies and unique guitar-violin blends have earned them Official SXSW status, a Sonic Guild grant, and features in Earmilk, EASTside Magazine, Austin-American Statesman, KUTX, and many more.
