## PARKING

Parking Fee – \$15 per vehicle as charged by the venue. Please come prepared to pay upon arrival.

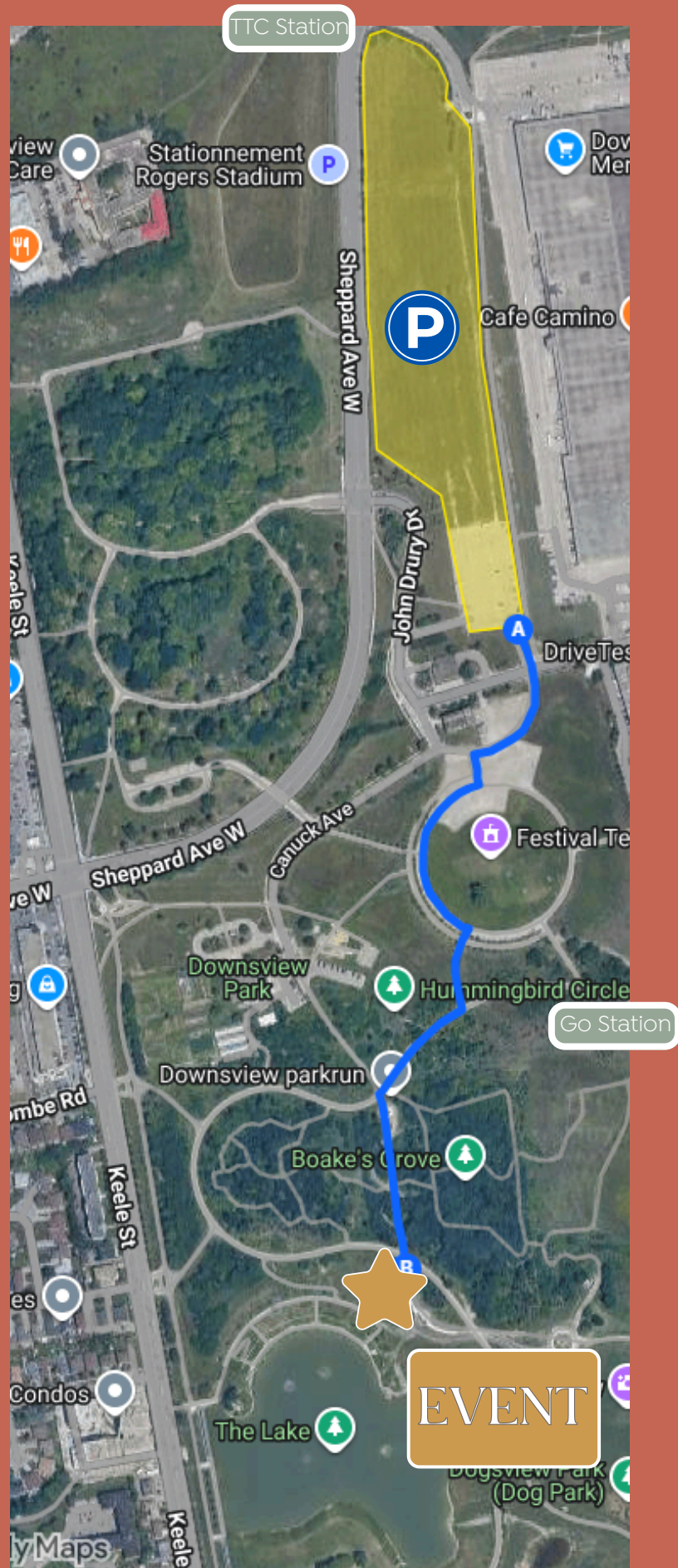
### Optional Shuttle Service –

For those who'd like to skip the 0.6-mile (1 km) walk from the parking area to the festival grounds, a paid shuttle service will be available.

To the Event: Pre-purchase your one-way shuttle ticket for \$10 per person or pay on site (space permitting).

Return Trip: If you'd like a ride back to the parking area after the event, the shuttle provider will collect payment on site—no advance purchase needed.

Enjoy a smooth arrival and departure by planning your parking and shuttle needs in advance! Please note that all parking is managed by the venue.



# LANTERN LAUNCH

## PLEASE NOTE

Our lantern launch is subject to weather conditions which may impact the lanterns movement on the water.

## DECORATE YOUR LANTERN

1. Decorate your lantern with messages of empowerment, remembrance, and connection.
2. Push the four rods into each corner of the lantern base and slide the paper sleeve over the rods
3. Place the LED candle in the center of the lantern.
4. Listen for instructions and launch your lantern during the designated window.
