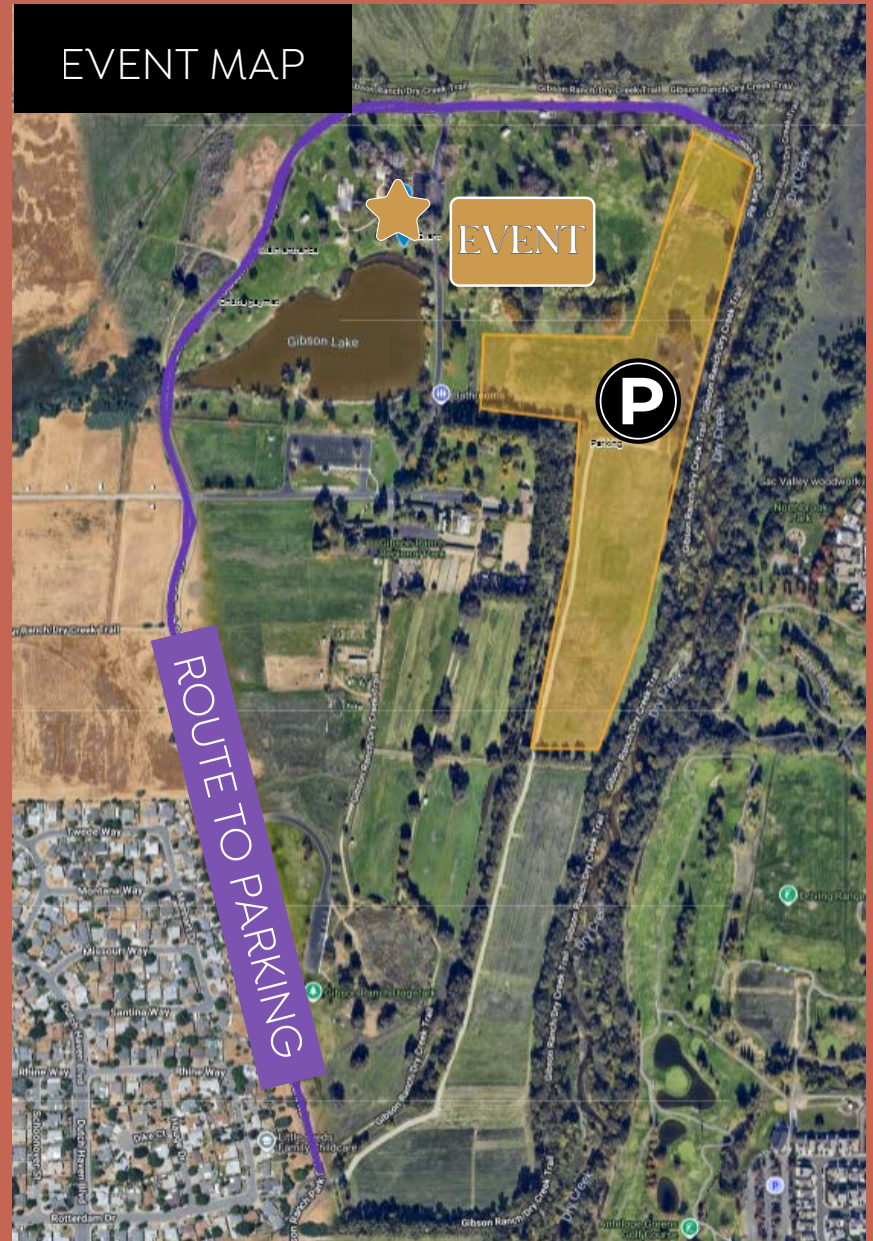
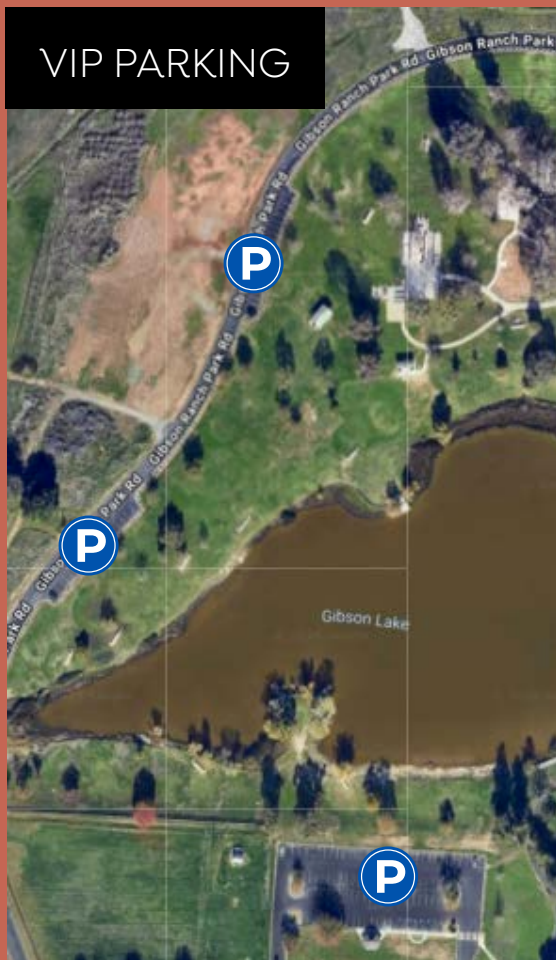

PLEASE NOTE

Our lantern launch is subject to weather conditions which may impact the lanterns movement on the water.

DECORATE YOUR LANTERN

1. Decorate your lantern with messages of empowerment, remembrance, and connection.
2. Push the four rods into each corner of the lantern base and slide the paper sleeve over the rods
3. Place the LED candle in the center of the lantern.
4. Listen for instructions and launch your lantern during the designated window.



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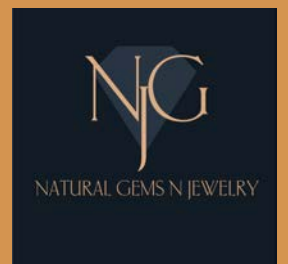
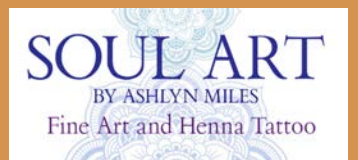

TYLER EDWARDS

Beginning his career in 2008, Tyler wrote and performed with his college rock band in South Carolina. After releasing two EPs and an LP, the band had multiple songs breaking the Top 10 on Billboard's Rock Charts and music featured on MTV and NASCAR. In 2015, Edwards launched his solo career with a 6-song EP, "Too Young for Love" and relocated to Seattle, Washington. Since that time, Tyler has cultivated a strong grass-roots by consistently touring and selling out some of Seattle's most notable venues and opening for national touring artists such as Ian Noe, Will Hoge, Nicki Bluhm, The Steel Wheels, as well as serving as direct tour support for Grizfolk (2025). The stark honesty and passion that make



his live shows so compelling also translates into his recorded work. Ear to the Ground Music notes, "... Edwards has a genuineness about him that makes his album infinitely listenable." In 2017, Edwards released his crowd-funded debut full length album, "A Few Good Hearts." A career of independence and determination has crafted Tyler into a hardworking musician and genuine songwriter. On May 1st, 2020, during the Covid-19 pandemic, he released his first self produced and self recorded EP, "Sincerely, Montgomery," which further solidified Edwards as an independent artist. Recently relocating to Northern California, he continues to tour and release new music following his sophomore album, "A Falling Sky." "Edwards is an effective communicator. He never needs to yell to get our attention... He writes and sings because he has something to say, rather than any overwhelming need to be seen and/or heard" - Curious for Music.
