Using insights from LinkedIn Recruiter, we've analysed how many IT professionals are currently 'open to work.' This data reveals:




- Where you might be at risk of losing people




## Networking

Currently, 25.5% of networking professionals are open to work.

Junior professionals are the most active job seekers, with 28% looking for new roles, while 24% of senior networking specialists are also considering a move.










### Infrastructure

22.4% of infrastructure professionals are currently open to new opportunities. Junior and senior professionals are equally affected, with 24% in both groups considering career changes, highlighting the need for retention strategies across all levels.









## Cybersecurity

Cybersecurity remains a high-turnover sector, with 33.5% of professionals open to work. Junior professionals are leading this shift, with 38% seeking new roles, while 30% of senior cybersecurity specialists are also exploring new opportunities.









## Cloud Computing

With cloud adoption accelerating, 30% of professionals in this field are open to work. Junior cloud specialists are the most likely to move, with 35% seeking new roles, while 28% of senior cloud experts are also considering a career change.








#### IT Sales

22% of IT sales professionals are open to new opportunities. Junior professionals show a slightly higher movement at 23%, while 20% of senior sales experts are also exploring job changes.










# IT Project Management

28% of IT project managers are open to work. Interestingly, senior professionals have a higher movement rate at 31%, compared to 26% of junior project managers, suggesting leadership roles may face higher turnover.
