Dr. Flo Cofer Announces Candidacy for Sacramento County Supervisor, District 1

Sacramento, CA — Dr. Flo Cofer, a public health expert, educator, longtime Sacramento resident, and 2024 mayoral candidate, announced today that she is running for Sacramento County Supervisor in District 1.

“County decisions shape our lives at the moments that matter most—during public health emergencies, housing crises, floods, wildfires, and when families need care and support,” said Cofer. “I’m running because Sacramento County can do better by the people who live here—and because leadership at this level must be transparent, accountable, and rooted in care.”

In her 2024 mayoral race, Cofer sparked an unprecedented grassroots movement, rising from a first-time candidate to come within half a percentage point of winning—the closest mayoral race in Sacramento history. Now, she is bringing that momentum to county leadership.

Cofer brings with her decades of experience in Sacramento’s public health and community leadership, with a focus on prevention, equity, and practical solutions that improve daily life. Her work has centered on keeping communities safe, strengthening public systems, and ensuring the government shows up effectively in times of crisis.

“This race matters because county government is where policy becomes lived experience,” Cofer said. “People deserve leadership that listens, takes public concerns seriously, explains how decisions are made, and invites the public into the process—not just during elections, but every day.”

“I want voters to know who I am, what I stand for, and how I will serve,” Cofer said. “Together, we can build a safer, more affordable, and more livable Sacramento County—because more is possible.”
