The strategic location of Marina Genova, next to Genoa's airport, opens exciting new possibilities for electric boating, enabling seamless and sustainable exploration of the entire port area. Electric boat users can now easily navigate the Genoa's historic port and beyond, fostering eco-friendly day trips or extended journeys along the Ligurian coast. The new Aqua 75 DC marine fast charge station has been switched on to coincide with the Genoa Boat Show, running from the 18th until the 23rd September.

"This collaboration with Aqua superPower is a game-changer for sustainable boating in Liguria," said Giuseppe Salamanca, Chief of Operations at Marina Genova. "The new charging station not only supports cleaner navigation but also positions Genoa as a leader in the global transition to electric maritime transport."
