Two New Enriching Public Amenities Unveiled Next Week

Friends of Special Children, a nonprofit that has served local children since 2001, raised funds over the past two years to build an open-aired pavilion and nature trail for Signal Centers program participants and staff, as well as the larger Chattanooga community. Now, it's time for the grand opening to celebrate how both projects have transformed the property.

The Friends Pavilion has space to accommodate 100 people with amenities such as a fire pit and full kitchen. The Adventure Trail is a 1/8-mile loop that has enriching, kid-friendly features along the way, including a book nook, bird blind, labyrinth, garden and play mounds.
