

Thriving School Community

Kinross Wolaroi School is home to a vibrant community of 1,100 students ranging from Pre-Kindergarten to Year 12. With 350 boarders, we stand out as one of Australia's most popular co-educational boarding schools. Our diverse student body fosters a dynamic and inclusive environment where lifelong friendships are forged for both students and their families.

Prime Location

Nestled in a safe and healthy country setting, Kinross Wolaroi School is easily accessible from all over the State. Our school benefits from excellent transport links, including road, rail, and air connections, making it a convenient choice for families. Located in a thriving regional city, we offer a one-stop educational option for families with both boys and girls, all at family-friendly fees.

Engaging Weekend Activities

Our boarding program ensures that 70% of our boarders remain in-house each weekend, creating a vibrant and connected community. We offer a variety of activities, including movies, swimming, theatre, baking, barbecues, camp-outs, mountain biking, and more. These activities promote camaraderie and provide a fun, balanced boarding experience.

Tailored Boarding Experience

Our boarding facilities are tailored to meet the unique needs of our boarders. Boys are accommodated on the main campus with dedicated houses for Years 7-8 and mixed houses for Years 9-12. Girls are housed on a separate campus, with Year 7 students together in their own house and mixed houses for Years 8-12. With dedicated Heads of Girls and Boys Boarding, we fine-tune our programs to match the needs of each group, while fostering co-educational interactions and sibling time.



State-of-the-Art Facilities

Kinross Wolaroi School boasts two 50-acre campuses with state-of-the-art facilities. Each boarding house features attractive and comfortable interior-designed common areas for gatherings and quiet spaces for privacy. Our recreational facilities include an indoor eight-lane 25m heated pool, an outdoor pool, two fully equipped Recreation Centres with gym facilities, movie screens, student kitchens, and extensive manicured gardens.

Academic Excellence

Academic support is a cornerstone of our boarding program. We offer structured prep sessions in the evenings, supervised by our academic staff, along with access to our free Study Hub. Our focused literacy programs for new Year 7 boarders ensure every student has the opportunity to excel academically.



Diverse Co-Curricular Opportunities

Our co-curricular activities cater to a wide range of interests and passions. From debating and cadets to the Duke of Edinburgh Award, musical ensembles, private music tuition, drama, community service, and annual school productions, there is something for everyone. We also offer nationally recognised swimming and rowing programs.

Holistic Wellbeing Support

Wellbeing is a key focus at Kinross Wolaroi School. Our dedicated program addresses the challenges of adolescence in a developmentally appropriate way, delivered by trained staff. We limit the number of staff in each house to ensure students are well known and understood. Our experienced carers are attuned to the needs of young people living away from home. We also welcome families to visit and encourage students to spend weekends at home, maintaining strong family connections.


