1. Payment of Fees

All tuition and boarding fees are payable in advance in Australian Dollars (AUD) prior to the commencement of the program.

Goods and services tax ("GST") (currently 10%) may apply to some fees and charges payable to the School. GST is included in the total boarding fee. However, if the rate of GST is changed or if, for any reason, GST becomes payable in respect of any other fees and charges payable to the School, the School may change the boarding fee or any other fee or charge. Charges incurring GST are indicated with an asterix.

2. Capital Levy

Family Capital Levy - An annual Family Capital Levy of \$900 per family is charged in four instalments per year. Where a family has only a Year 12 student enrolled, the levy will be charged in three instalments. These funds are used by the School to maintain and develop the grounds and facilities.

3. Elective Activity Charges

Kinross Wolaroi School offers a broad range of elective academic, sporting, and co-curricular programs. Some of these electives incur additional charges due to the higher costs associated with their delivery.

ACADEMIC

- Excursions related to elective subjects in Years 9-12 are optional and will attract additional charges.
- Additional fees apply to certain academic pathways, including Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses, Distance Education subjects, Industrial Technology project costs, etc.

Families will be notified in advance of these charges.

COCURRICULAR

Specific charges apply to high-cost co-curricular programs to reflect their significant fixed costs. These charges are introduced to ensure the sustainability and equity of School resourcing.

- These charges will be applied at key points during the School year (e.g. start of season).
- Additional activity-specific costs (e.g. regatta fees, camp charges) will continue to apply separately.

4. Additional Charges

Charges will be advised in advance of the activity. Example costs include, but are not limited to:

- Parents and Friends Association contribution - \$45 per annum (per family)
- Optional Cadet Courses - such as Promotions Camp
- Duke of Edinburgh Awards program
- Uniform
- Equipment Hire
- Optional Curricular and Co-curricular activities
- Swimming Club levies - costs associated with registration, activities and administration for attendance at swimming competitions (NB: there are no charges to participate in the school-based swimming program)
- Additional Private Sports Coaching
- Representative Sport Participation / Attendance at Competitions
- Private Instrumental Music Lessons and Instrument Hire
- Late-Bus Service
- NSW Train Link tickets (Boarding students)
- Taxis
