- Profit from their activities at the club or use SWSC premises or equipment to promote private trading or business interests.
- Promote, publish or post views or information that may harm the reputation of the club.
- Defraud, or attempt to defraud SWSC in any way.

Failure to comply with the rules and procedures of the club may render members subject to disciplinary action.
