Where to Place QR Codes for Maximum Accessibility and Impact

Navigation & Wayfinding

Accessible QR codes like NaviLens can dramatically improve how guests navigate hospitality spaces, particularly for those with visual or cognitive impairments.

Floor Plans and Building Layouts

- Place codes at entrances, lifts, and stairwells to provide floor plans or venue maps.
- Allow guests to identify key areas such as the bar, tills, toilets, evacuation points, and exits.

Signage at the Entrance

- Codes displaying opening hours, Wi-Fi details, etc.

Table and Service Area Wayfinding

Codes guiding customers to the correct area: order point,
 collection counter, seating.

Information Sharing



Accessible QR codes can also deliver detailed, useful information in inclusive formats, enhancing both usability and engagement.

Use Cases:

Restrooms (Toilet Signs)

- Codes on restroom doors clearly identifying gender, accessibility (e.g., "Accessible Toilet"), or baby-changing facilities.
- Codes providing interior layout descriptions: location of sink, handrails, toilet, steps, or door types.

Special Offers and Events

- Information about upcoming events, live music, seasonal specials, or daily and themed menus.
