### Third Avenue Street Festival Returns!



On Saturday, July 12th, 2025, the Third Avenue Street Festival returned after more than 6 years from E 149th Street to E 153rd Street! The festival has deep roots in our local history, going back decades, where it was recognized as a celebration of culture and community. BID staff were honored to bring this festival back with the support of our sponsors, partners, and city agencies. The festival attracted hundreds of shoppers to the area, where many enjoyed live performances, food, shopping, and community services. We plan to continue this tradition every summer.

## **Roberto Clemente Plaza**





Earlier this month, temporary barriers were installed around Roberto Clemente Plaza to allow the city to conduct strategic multi-agency operations in and around the Hub to address quality of life issues that had escalated in recent months. In the meantime, a temporary NYPD mobile station has been installed at the center of the plaza while agencies and organizations address complex and sensitive issues. Additionally, DOT and the Horticulture Society of New York continue to support the ongoing maintenance and beautification of the Plaza, with new plantings this month. The BID continues to partner with city agencies, elected officials, and local organizations to prepare this valued green space for the public. Stay tuned!





