Position Summary:

The Department of Public Safety operates Monday through Friday during normal business hours. The Public Safety Ambassador supports a safe and secure environment for stakeholders, tenants and visitors to Third Avenue. Ambassadors will be expected to: observe & report information as it relates to Quality-of-Life conditions; provide members of the public with helpful information on attractions and businesses in the area; execute several comprehensive and integrated security measures and countermeasures. Must be able to adapt to the changing needs and priorities of the Department of Public Safety and the Third Avenue BID.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

(Includes unique competencies) Individual must be **licensed** as a New York State Security Guard; have basic computer knowledge (email, Microsoft Office a plus); a professional appearance; ability to detect problems and report information to the appropriate personnel; excellent verbal communication and report writing skills; able to operate departmental equipment - including radios; use sound and proper judgment when addressing emergency situations; able to listen and communicate calmly, effectively, and courteously in both emergency and non-emergency situations. With advance notice, must be available to shift schedule for special events (evening/weekend) when necessary. Bi-lingual a plus.

Working Conditions:

Ambassadors will be exposed to working outdoors for prolonged periods of time including in inclement weather conditions. Must be available to work at BID-sponsored events as needed (e.g.: Third Ave Street Festival, Plaza Events, Winter Wonderland, etc.)

Physical Requirements:

Public Safety Officers must be in good health and physical condition to maintain the physical stamina and agility, visual and auditory acuity necessary to perform the essential



responsibilities of this position. Must be able to engage in strenuous physical activity including: foot patrolling, walking, running, and standing for extended periods, climbing and descending stairs, the movement of barricades (roughly 25-40lbs) and other items.

Education:

High School Diploma or Equivalency; College Degree preferred

Salary: \$20 an hour
