Join Us: June 30th BID Annual Member Meeting



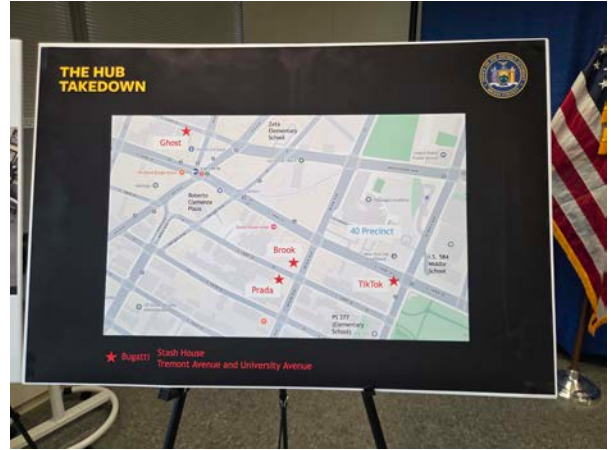

BID Awarded AARP Community Challenge Grant



Earlier this month, AARP announced that the Third Avenue BID was 1 of 750 grantees to receive a 2026 AARP Community Challenge Grant to make the Hub more livable for people of all ages. Bronx BIDs Meet with SBS Commissioner and City Agencies



Earlier this month, Bronx BIDs met with SBS Commissioner Kenny Minaya, the office of Deputy Mayor Su, and city agencies to discuss the top priorities of neighborhoods across the Bronx. The 12 Bronx BIDs represent over 300 block faces and approximately 3,000 storefronts. As the new administration implements its affordability agenda, many BIDs elevated the need for increased investments in public safety, small business support, public space activations, and other vital programming. The BIDs also emphasized the need to cut red tape not just for small businesses, but also for the non-profit organizations like BIDs that support them, by streamlining the process for grants and reimbursements. We look forward to working with Commissioner Minaya and the administration to revitalize neighborhoods and support small businesses.
