### Message to All Springhurst Community Homeowners

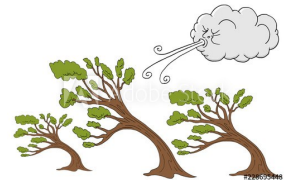
After multiple notices, interest fees have been applied to all homeowner's accounts where the dues have not been paid.

## Grounds Committee

May 2023

Your Springhurst Community Association, with the assistance of its Grounds Committee members and landscape maintenance contractor, has continued to identify and remove **dead and declining trees** from the community. These have primarily consisted of ash trees, white pines, and crabapples. The ash trees are significantly impacted by the region's emerald ash borer. We believe necessary tree removal is critical to the overall appearance of our Springhurst Community. A significant number of **removed trees that are in high visibility areas are replaced** to maintain the green nature of the community. Unfortunately, we have lost several trees to the **recent wind storms**.



It is equally important for Springhurst **residents** to remove trees (and shrubbery) from their property that are dead or in significant decline. Aside from the improved aesthetics of removing dead and diseased trees and their impact on property values, **is the safety issue**. Unhealthy trees are in danger of falling onto house, autos, fences, and even people. The recent high wind events we have experienced may have further weakened trees. Trees that are leaning or that have **raised root bases** at the ground level should be considered for removal. Such trees are weaker and in danger of being uprooted in wind/rain events.

**Neglected trees**, in the event they fall, may not be covered under your homeowner insurance policy. Also, many shrubs have been severely damaged by the December winter-burn. Some varieties **will not recover** and should be removed/replaced. Springhurst is in the process of identifying and removing common area plantings that will not recover and we are planning for replacements.

The Springhurst Community Association and your neighbors will appreciate **your attention** to the removal and replacement of damaged, unhealthy trees and other plantings on your property. The entire community will benefit from your attention to this issue. **Thank YOU!**

## Pool and Clubhouse

Who will be the “**first in**” the Springhurst pool this year? **Opening day is Saturday, May 27!** Thanks to the Pool and Clubhouse Committee and our property manager, plans are well underway to have everything in top-notch shape and ready for a great **Memorial Day** weekend.

As always, photos required for pool entry will be taken by the gate staff. **ALL members age six and over** must have photos made, so please be cooperative when requested by the gate attendant.

Remember that all association and **member payments** must be paid, and legal fees, a completed 2023 census form must be furnished to the SCA Office, and **you may be required to furnish a Photo ID.** Household members only may be included on your pool census form. A “household member” is a spouse, child, or other family member whose legal residence is a member’s home. **Proof of residence will be required each year** for non-owner household members over 24 years of age.

Pool Rules will be available to registered users on [springhurstvillages.com](http://springhurstvillages.com), on the bulletin board, and at the pool gate. **Please be familiar with the rules** and remember that they are in place to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all members and guests.

Please comply with the instructions by **pool staff at all times.** You may contact the property manager with any complaint or disagreement.
