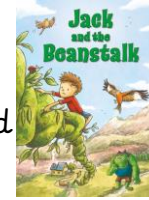
English

We will be looking at the stories 'Rain' and 'Jack and the Beanstalk' this term. Here are some activities that you might like to do at home. You can bring in your learning at the end of the term.



P.E.



We will be sequencing movements to create a dance. Have a go at creating your own dance routine that you can teach to a friend or family member. Take some photos or teach us at school!

We will be learning about plants and what they need to grow. You may wish to gather things that you need to grow a plant or flower at home. Complete a diary each week explaining your findings. You may notice that shoots or leaves have appeared!



Science

P.S.H.E.



In PSHE, we will be thinking about Healthy Me. We will consider all the things we do to keep ourselves healthy. You could plan a healthy meal or create a poster to share with others about staying healthy.



Maths

We will be exploring measurement of length and height. You could have a go at comparing the lengths or heights of objects at home. Can you put them in order from the shortest to the longest?

Art



We will be focusing on the artist Henri Matisse. Collect an object from outside and have a go at drawing it. Look carefully at markings and patterns and see if you can recreate these with your pencils, felt tips or crayons.

We will be learning about different sounds of instruments. This is called **timbre**. What sounds can you make with items in your home? Which sounds are similar? Why? Think about what the items are made from!
