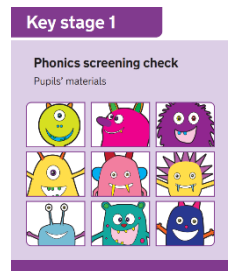


How to help your Year One Child with English - Summer Term Objectives

Reading

- Recognise and identify all graphemes taught so far (review this term)
- Apply their known phonics to segment and blend words accurately
- Re-read sentences for fluency and then expression
- Spot digraphs within words and use alternative phonemes when necessary
- Phonics Screening Check will be the week beginning 9th June
- Respond appropriately to questions asked about what they have read (comprehension)
- Look back through the text to find key words or phrases to help with understanding



Writing

- Add the suffixes -ing, -ed, -er and -est to create new words
- Add prefix 'un' at the beginning of a word to create a new word
- Add the suffixes -s and -es to show plurals
- Use correct punctuation in sentences (E.g. capital letter, full stop, question mark, exclamation mark)
- Re-read sentences to check for sense
- Re-read sentences to edit and improve
- Extend sentences with conjunctions such as 'and' and 'because'

Handwriting

Our children have made great progress with their handwriting this year. For the summer term, we will be focussing on accurate letter joins and their position on the line. Children need to ensure that their capital letters are larger than the lowercase and are not joined. Ascenders and descenders need to be clear.
