Accelerated Reader @ Leigham Primary

- Star assessment calculates ZPD
- An adaptive test that reacts to the children's previous responses
- Children can then use their ZPD to choose books from our school library/myOn
- Quizzes are completed in school and are independent
- It is not a memory test, so they can skim their books to locate information
- Quizzes use multi-choice questions
- Children will repeat their star assessment four times during an academic year (Autumn, Christmas, Spring and Summer)
- Children can choose within their range (2.4 3.4) but are encouraged to start at the lower range so ensure they are achieving success






myOn

Times Tables Check


- A three-week window from Monday 1st







