Every week, the new Johns Island building hits another construction milestone and we can't wait to open the doors in the Spring of 2026. The walls are in place, the roof is installed, and the cross sits high on the steeple. Your generosity is making a way for generations to come and experience God in community.

In September 2025, we met a \$500,000 match, and we are now working toward a \$1.6 million match provided by Seacoast after the sale of land in Mount Pleasant. Completing that match will increase our raised amount to over \$11 million. Our desire is to raise the entire cost of the project, \$14.5 million, and be debt free when we open the doors. This will allow us to direct more of our resources to other ministry opportunities across Seacoast.

greenville building project


Seacoast is praying and searching for a permanent home for the Greenville Campus—one that will host weekend services, weekly small groups, and local missions opportunities.

By the end of 2025, we are on track to complete more than 10,000 appointments and serve over 3,000 people. Our Mount Pleasant and Summerville locations are thriving, welcoming nearly 200 clients each week. Looking ahead, we hope to expand into West Ashley and Johns Island within the next year.

The Retreat at Church Creek provides a lifegiving refuge for ministry leaders from around the world—pastors who are facing exhaustion, isolation, and the growing mental health crisis within the church. Located on 66 beautiful waterfront acres, this sanctuary offers pastors a place to relax, recharge, and reconnect with likeminded leaders.

Since the Retreat opened in 2021, we have served over 2,729 pastors and leaders from 600 churches with a goal of serving 10,000 pastors and leaders by 2027.


