Access Control Permit Drawings

Access Control Permit Drawings - The drawing set required by the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) to demonstrate that the electric locking devices installed as part of the access control system do not block the means of egress, according to the local & state codes. The typical drawing set includes a floor plan showing the access control devices being installed, a fail-safe diagram, specifications sheets, and other items required by the AHJ. GDS coordinates the submittal of the drawing set with our customers and the local AHJ, and prints the approved, red stamped plans for the field inspection.

Revision to Approved Plans

This is a change to a plan that was already approved by the AHJ, but <u>before</u> the plan passed field inspection, a change occurs that requires the plan to be resubmitted back to the AHJ for approval.

Incidental changes, such as missing or incorrect information on plans	no charge
Change to the original scope of work, such as adding a new door or new floor plan layout	\$200
Each additional new door added to an approved plan	\$50

Shop Drawings

This is a simple device layout plan done <u>concurrently</u> with access control permit drawings. This plan is typically for the end user. It shows items on the permit set, plus other non-permitted items, such as control panels, power supplies, video recorders, cameras, burglar alarm sensors, keypads and similar devices. Shop drawings do <u>not</u> include cover sheet, one-line, details, elevations, panel layout, and point-to-point or hook-up drawings, which can be found on the GDS Access Control and Security Submittal / As-Built Drawing price list.
