

Moveo Technologies Corporation (dba drvn) Privacy Policy - 06/04/2025

Moveo Technologies Corporation (dba drvn) ("MTC") maintains robust privacy protections as stated within our Privacy Policy. This policy describes how we collect, use, share, and protect personal information when you use our website (<https://www.drvn.com/>). We may also collect user interaction data from emails and digital campaigns for internal analytics and personalized experiences, provided the user has given consent. By Using this Site, you consent to the data practices described in this policy.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect and use the following types of information from those who use the Site:

- (a) Personal Information by which you may be personally identified, such as your name, address, email address, phone number, and other information, such as your username and passwords that may not be publicly available.
- (b) Non-personal Information about you that does not identify you personally, including, but not limited to, search requests for, communications with us and third parties, Site feedback or suggestions, search queries, product reviews, and any other activities when using the Site.
- (c) Technical Information includes your operating system, software, traffic, and location data. This may also include device identifiers, browser types, session times, and clickstream behavior for internal performance and experience analysis.

2. Purpose of Data Collection

We are the sole owners of information collected from visitors on this Site. We will not sell or rent your information to third parties. We use information collected from you or about you, including personal information, for the following purposes:

- (a) Respond to user inquiries.
- (b) Administer and improve the Site.
- (c) Analyze trends and track visitor activity.
- (d) Collect target demographic data.
- (e) Develop and personalize digital content, email campaigns, or on-site experiences based on user behavior, provided users have given explicit consent to receive marketing communications.

3. Data Sharing and Disclosure

We may share your information with:

- (a) Affiliates, including any subsidiaries we now own or later acquire.
- (b) Trusted employees, contractors, business partners, service providers, suppliers, vendors, and other third parties that support us, which may include sending you emails on our behalf, analyzing your activities and interactions on the Site to make improvements to the Site and experiences of our visitors; and providing support to the Site, our Site operations, or fulfilling your requests. These third parties may only use personal information to provide such support and are contractually required to maintain the confidentiality of your information. All third-party vendors must comply with applicable data privacy laws, including GDPR and CCPA, where relevant.
- (c) Buyer, successor, or other third party due to a merger, restructuring, reorganization, or other transfer or disposition of MTC or our operations, including, but not limited to, in the event of a sale, bankruptcy, dissolution, or similar proceeding. In such an event, we will notify you if your information becomes subject to a different privacy policy.
- (d) In response to court orders, subpoenas, or legal processes, such as requests from government regulatory or law enforcement agencies; to defend, pursue, or participate in legal actions or proceedings or exercise a legal right; to take precautions against actual or potential liabilities; to investigate or respond to potential or suspected illegal activities, fraud, or threats to the Site, its visitors, or the property or physical safety of any person; to enforce or investigate violations of our terms of use; or as otherwise permitted or required by law. Such disclosures will be limited to what is legally required and proportionate.

4. Use of Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We collect the following types of information from you as you use the Site through automatic data collection technologies. This information is not connected to personal information and is used for administering the Site, analyzing trends, tracking visitor activity, and collecting demographic data. Other details regarding your activities on the Site, including your equipment, operating system, software, traffic information, and location data. Our automatic data collection includes the use of the following technologies: Tracking tools may also be used in email communications to measure engagement with newsletters or transactional messages.

- (a) Cookies. A small piece of data is stored on a visitor's hard drive to store information about visitor preferences and activities on the Site. We use this information to optimize our visitors' experiences. For instance, a cookie can help us identify you when you return to the Site to save you time. You may also refuse to accept cookies by configuring the appropriate settings on your browser. (b) Web Beacons. A small file (also known as a clear gif or pixel tag) that is embedded on a webpage, email, video, or other content that allows us to collect data about visitors who interact with such web pages or emails, such as recording when such content is accessed and reading other information from your browser. You may be able to turn off web beacons in our email communications by turning off "images" in your email client settings. However, doing so may prevent you from adequately enjoying our Site as they are designed to be used.

(c) Flash Cookies. A local shared object (a text file) is sent from a web server to a client when a browser requests content supported by the Adobe Flash browser plug-in. Your preferences for flash cookies are not managed in the same way as browser cookies. Instead, you may change your preferences for flash cookies by changing your settings on Adobe's website.

(d) DoubleClick DART Cookies. A cookie that, according to Google, Inc., "is used by Google in the ads served on publisher websites displaying AdSense for content ads. When users visit an AdSense publisher's website and either view or click on an ad, a cookie may be dropped on that end user's browser. The data gathered from these cookies will help AdSense publishers better serve and manage the ads on their site(s) and across the web." (e) Google Analytics. We may use Google Analytics or similar services to collect non-personal information from you regarding your use of the Site. Google Analytics is a web analytics service offered by Google, Inc. that mainly uses cookies to report on your interactions on the Site and analyzes how you use the Site. For more information on Google Analytics, including how to set up privacy controls on how Google Analytics collects your information, please see their help articles. We use IP anonymization features and honor regional opt-out settings where applicable. (f) Log file information commonly collected by host servers when you visit websites, including internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time stamps, referring/exit pages, domain names, landing pages, pages viewed, click counts, and similar information.

We do not track visitors' activities over time or across third-party websites and, therefore, do not respond to Do Not Track (DNT) signals. However, many third-party websites track your browsing activities to tailor advertisements and other content to your interests. If you do not wish to be tracked in this manner, you should configure your browser settings appropriately.

5. Data Retention

We retain personal information as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this policy unless a more extended retention period is required or permitted by law.

We store personal information on secure servers located in the United States. In the course of providing our services, we may use third-party service providers and cloud infrastructure partners to process data on our behalf. These providers operate under strict contractual obligations and do not retain personal information beyond what is necessary to perform their functions. Form submissions on our website are securely transmitted to internal systems and are not stored by external form tools, content management platforms, or automation services. We maintain appropriate technical and organizational measures to safeguard the transmission, processing, and storage of your data. We do not store or process personal data within the European Union. However, we monitor developments in international data protection laws, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), and implement appropriate safeguards—such as standard contractual clauses or data processing agreements—where required by law. Users located in the European Economic Area (EEA) or other regulated jurisdictions may request access to, restriction of, or deletion of their personal data.
