- **CAFOD:** Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent and CAFOD invites you to join as we seek to make space and time to draw closer to God and our global family through reflection and prayer this Lent. Each day in their emails they will share a reflection on one of the readings of the day, stories of our global family, a prayer and a suggested action you might like to take as we prepare for Easter. - **CAFOD FAMILY FAST DAY, 27 February 2026:** This Lent CAFOD's Family Fast Day on Friday 27 February invites parishes to respond through prayer, fasting and almsgiving to the needs of families facing floods and drought in places such as South Sudan, Bangladesh and Zimbabwe. Through support for CAFOD's Lent Appeal, parishes and schools can help families grow food and care for their communities in the face of the devastating impact of climate change. Our Parish is supporting this appeal and you can find CAFOD envelopes at the back of church, and we ask that you encourage school communities to support CAFOD's Family Fast Day Appeal. For Holy Week, members of our diocesan writing team will prepare a set of daily reflections based on the readings from Palm Sunday through to Easter Sunday. This collection of ***Daily Reflections for Holy Week 2026*** will be available on the diocesan website.

- **CHURCHES TOGETHER:** *Christ and the Chocolaterie* is a Christian Lent course designed for small groups or individuals. Based on the 2000 film *Chocolat* by Hilary Brand, it explores themes of change, gift-giving, and acceptance through film scenes, bible study and reflection, often featuring for example, a chocolate feast (challenging if we have given up chocolates!). The course will be held at St. Andrews at 2pm on 19th February, 26th February, 12th March and 26th March.
