PRAYERS FOR PEACE: To mark the 81st anniversary of the bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, a short ecumenical service will be held by the Peace Tree behind the St Cuthberts Centre at 3.00pm on **Sunday 9 August**.

ADOREMUS National Eucharistic Congress: As a diocese, Bishop Stephen hopes to take a contingent of approximately 30 pilgrims to participate in this significant national gathering. Adoremus offers a unique opportunity to deepen our devotion to the Eucharist, strengthen our faith, and join Catholics from across England and Wales in prayer, worship, and witness. The diocesan pilgrimage day will be **Saturday, 10 October 2026**, and we invite parishioners to prayerfully consider taking part in this event. The day will begin at St George's Cathedral, Southwark, where delegates from across the country will gather from 10.30am for presentations on Eucharistic Art and Life, alongside refreshments and information stands.
