An Early Start Denver Model-Based Group for Parents of Infants and Toddlers

The Center for Autism and Related Disabilities is now offering a *virtual* group for parents of infants/toddlers diagnosed with ASD.

An Early Start Denver Model-based group is being offered at no cost through the Center for Autism and Related Disabilities at the University at Albany. This group program provides parents with training and tools to promote their very young children's social and communicative development. The program includes small-group instruction to help parents learn real-world skills that will help them interact with their infants/toddlers in a way that has been shown to elicit social and communicative behaviors. Participants are asked to complete pre/post assessments in order for us to evaluate the effectiveness of this program.

Program Eligibility Requirements

Participants must:

- Be parent/caregiver of a 12-47 month old infant or toddler
- The infant or toddler must be:
 - Diagnosed with ASD or
 - At genetic risk for ASD
- Be motivated to learn skills for promoting infant/toddler development
- Be able to participate in all training sessions
- Participate in 12 weeks of program provided once per week on Mondays (time TBD), beginning on January 26, 2026
- Be willing to complete pre/post assessments
