Viewing

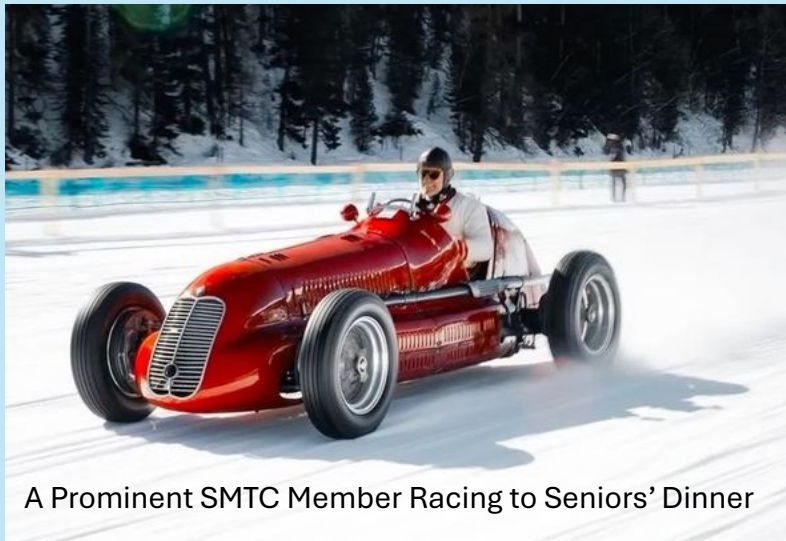

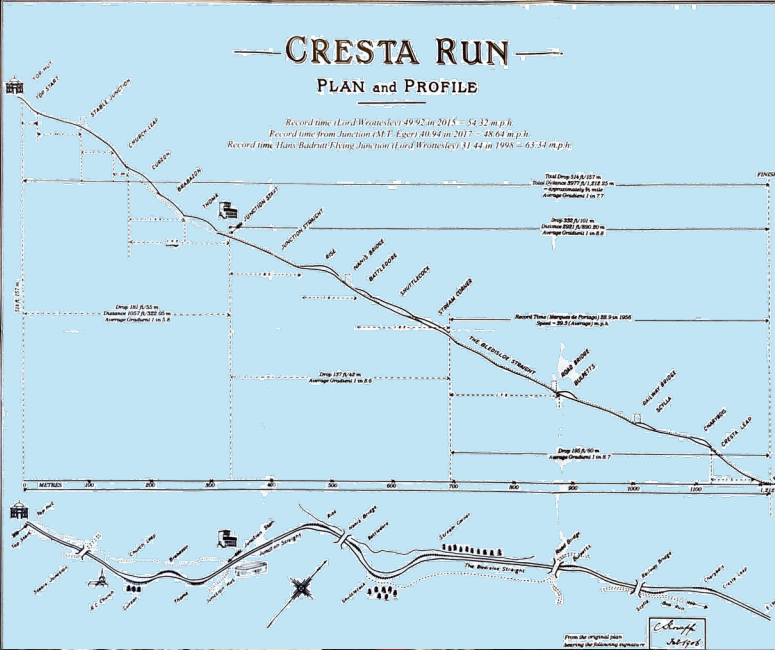
Seniors’ Dinner at Waldhaus Am See Hotel
