People wishing to write a tribute in person are asked to please bring a pen to ensure that hygiene rules are observed, and to extinguish the candle when they leave. Those wishing to send a tribute can email Andrew Marritt; he and Katheljine have offered to transcribe your thoughts and wishes. I would ask you to keep messages loving but short as this may well be a major undertaking for them.
