
Summer Events

Committee Meeting

What we don't expect to do every year is hold virtual Committee meetings as we did a fortnight ago. The key topics we discussed were:

- a. As explained at the AGM, we are in the final stages of creating a **new legal structure** which will ensure that we comply with all regulations both in the UK and in Switzerland. This process has been going on for some time and upon reaching a conclusion will be presented in full to the Membership in the near future we certainly hope this will be before next season. The structure may be different but the most important point to emphasise is that there will be no noticeable change for Members.
- b. The **survey**, also discussed at the AGM. The data about riding numbers, Members, SLs, etc., is being "mined" and we have appointed a specialist to collate questions for Members to answer. We hope the survey will be completed during the summer.
- c. A scenario, however unlikely, that we cannot build the Cresta Run next winter. Financially, I'm pleased to confirm the Hon Treasurer assures me we could weather that storm.
- d. The Calendar for next season, which you can see here, extends to Sunday March 7th. This elongation should allow more days in January for Beginners and SLs to have plenty of rides. You will spot the lovely addition of a new Junction Handicap in memory of Tazi (Jack) Glattfelder, to be run on the same day as the Marsden Cup. There will an event to attempt to break one of the oldest sporting records in the Portago Stream Cup on 30th December. There is also a Family Day on Tuesday January 2nd when fathers, daughters, brothers, and sisters, can all ride together.

New Members

We have elected a terrific group of new Members and you can see the full list <u>here</u>. Surprisingly twothirds of the candidates are impoverished Brits. Next season, hopefully the European quotient of applicants will be much higher. We will also be tweaking the application process so that every candidate has the prior support of a Committee member as well as their Proposer and Seconder.
