





Matopos Hills is also a Rhino Reserve so keep your eyes peeled.

For a man who could have asked to be buried anywhere in the world, including Westminster, Cecil Rhodes, the giant of colonial Africa, with a vision the size of the continent, chose to be buried in the high rolling rocks of the indigenous Malindidzimu Shrine (resting place of spirits) in the Matopos Hills, outside Bulawayo.

It is a magnificent place, which exceeds the imagination. The Founders of Rhodesia and Zimbabwe are buried in the sheer rock of this spiritual place, which is respected and protected by the current rulers, despite the colonial past.

Our agents and friends in Bulawayo, Piers, Jane and Charlie Taylor, the best-known guides in Zimbabwe, will host our trip to Rhodes grave, the Cresta "Down-Under" White Linen BBQ Lunch in the Matopos Hills, and our Cresta Colonial Carousal at the Bulawayo Club. These are exclusive opportunities to revel in Africa and the history of one of its colonial giants.

Private Buses, from the Bulawayo Club to Victoria Falls, will include the Hwange National Park Safari and a scenic drive of five and a half hours to Victoria Falls on Sat Oct 31st.

*** Flappers: Noun, A generation of young Western women in the 1920s who wore short skirts, bobbed their hair, listened to jazz, and flaunted their disdain for what was then considered acceptable behavior (a.k.a. Lady Cresta Riders)

Our expert game guide Charlie Taylor will be on hand to help with bird calls, the un-spotable lion or the galloping gazelle.


