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1.0 INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the 2 in 1 Smart TV Box supplied by STRONG. It has been produced with the latest new technology and offers extensive entertainment and great versatility. We wish you many hours of new great experiences exploring the Android world!

1.1 Safety Instructions

Read all of the instructions before operating the device. Keep these instructions well for later use.

- Only use attachments/accessories specified or provided by the manufacturer (such as the exclusive supply adapter, battery etc.).
- Please refer to the information on the product enclosure for electrical and safety information before installing or operating the apparatus.
- To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this apparatus to rain or moisture.
- The ventilation should not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings with items, such as newspaper, table-cloths, curtains, etc.
- The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus.

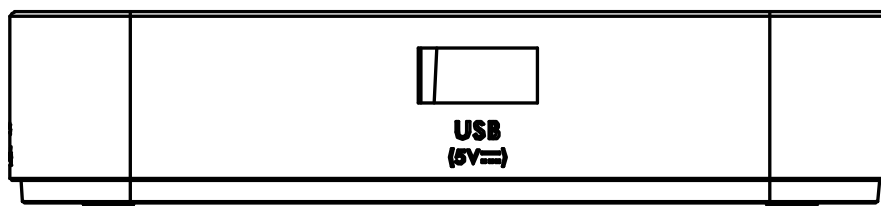

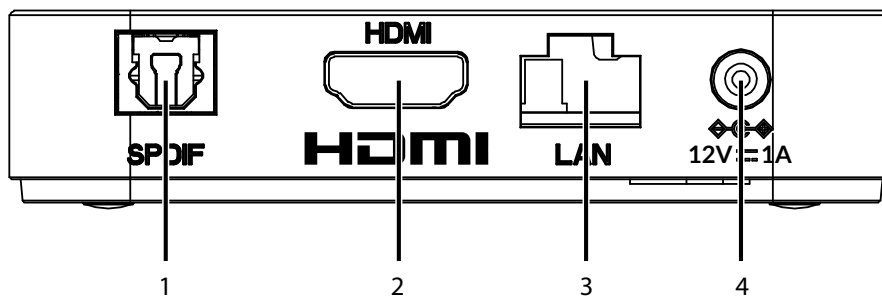

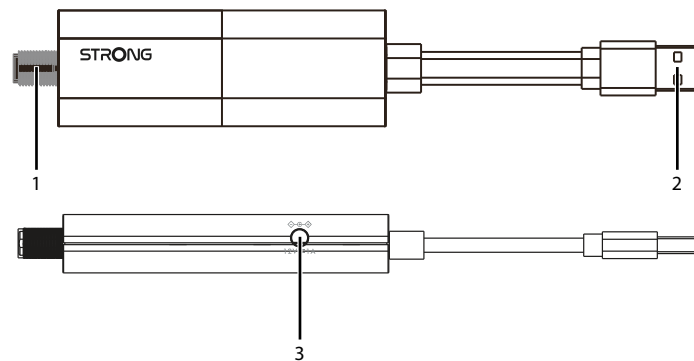

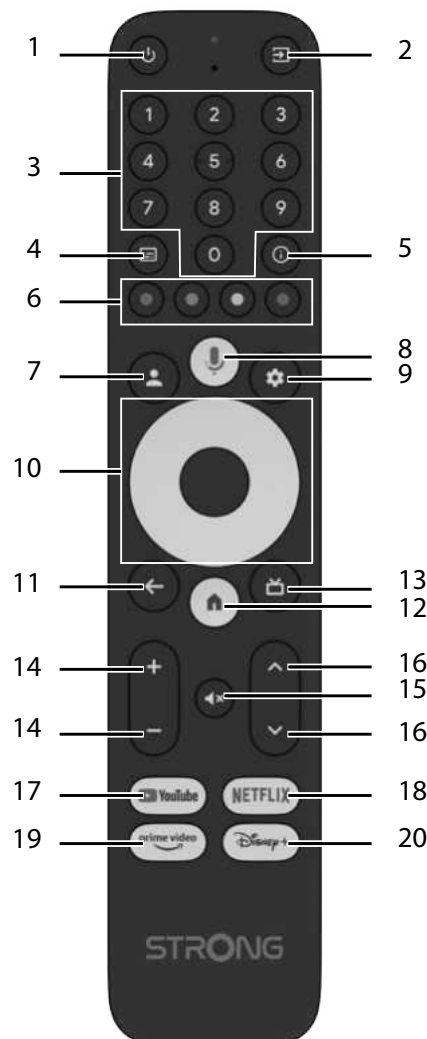

3. 0 to 9 Choose channel directly.
4. Subtitles / Audio selection
5. INFO Display information about the channel.

7. Press to execute the prompt function in Live TV mode.
8. Call account menu to select between accounts
9. Press to activate the voice control function*.
10. Direct access to settings menu.
11. Navigate the menu. Confirm the selection.

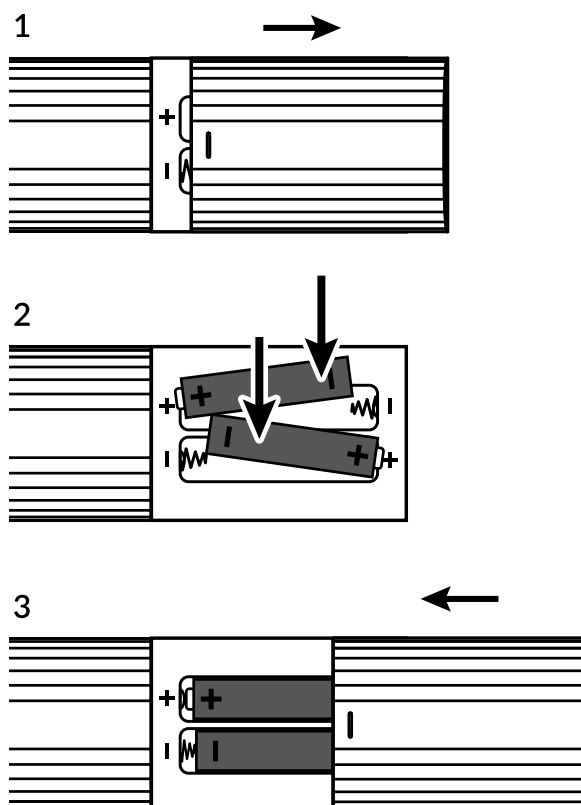

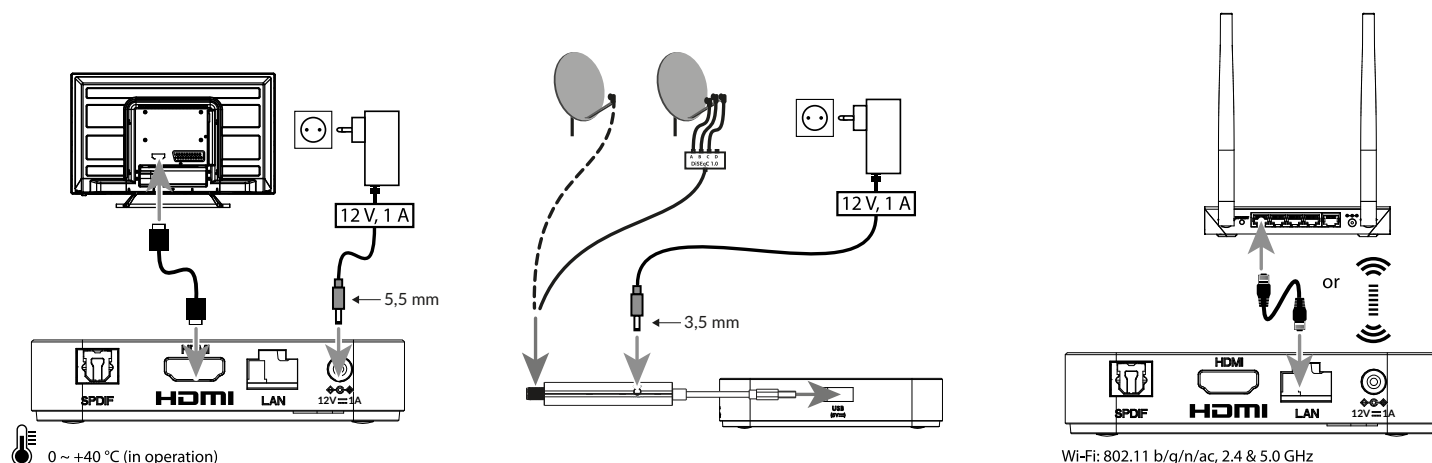

NOTE: The Google TV box also supports Wi-Fi 2.4GHz and 5GHz. To connect, go to Settings - Network.

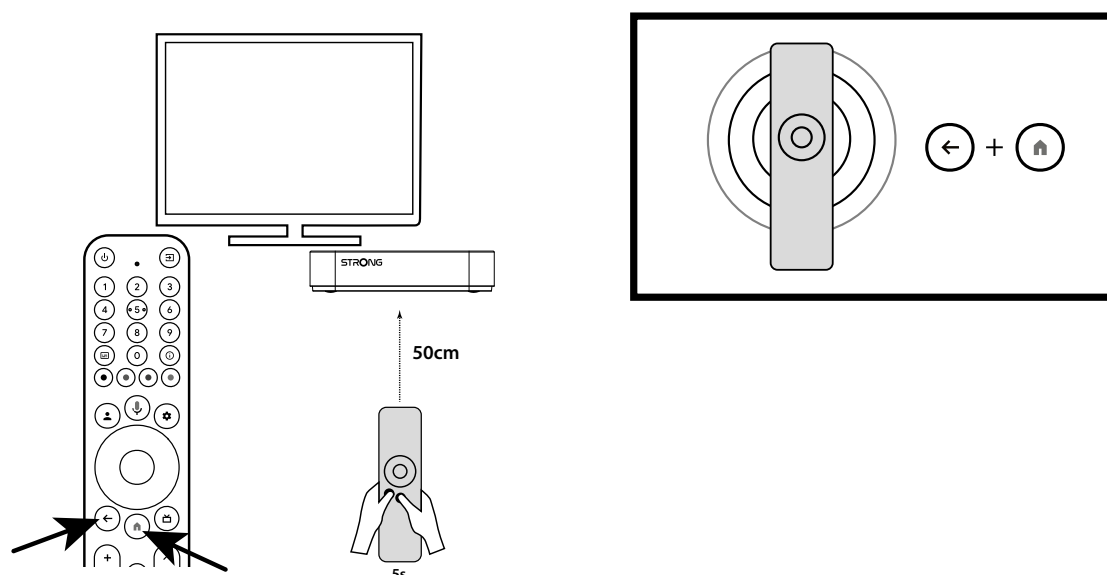
- Connect the Google TV box to your television via the HDMI Cable. Advice: use (the included) type 2.1 as this is supporting UHD, HDR, Dolby Vision resolutions.
- Using an Ethernet Cable, connect the LAN Port of the Google TV Box to the LAN Port of your router or home broadband network.
- Connect the satellite dongle to the Google TV Box via the USB cable.
- Connect the satellite dongle to your satellite antenna
- Connect the Google TV Box and the satellite dongle to power using the power adapter provided. You can then power on your device and begin.

NOTE: Before turning on your device, please switch the signal input of the TV to the correct source

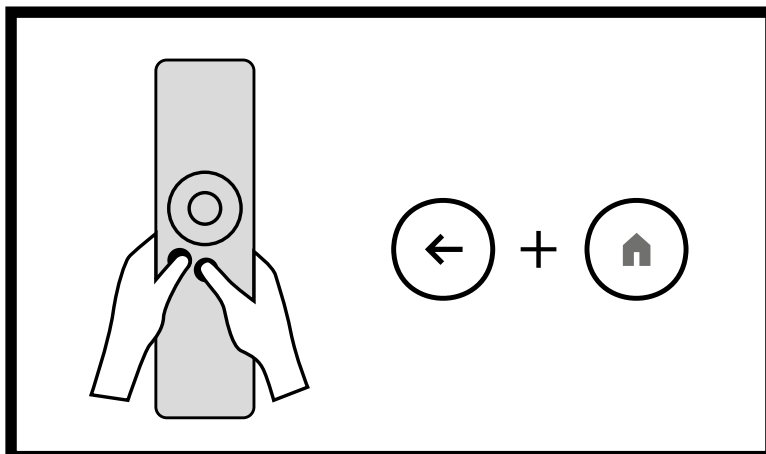
4.0 SETTING UP YOUR GOOGLE TV BOX

To be able to use Google Assistant on your remote, you must first pair your Bluetooth Remote to your TV Box for 5 seconds. Follow the pairing instructions on the screen.

Press ◀ and 🏠 together for 5 seconds. The LED will start blinking.

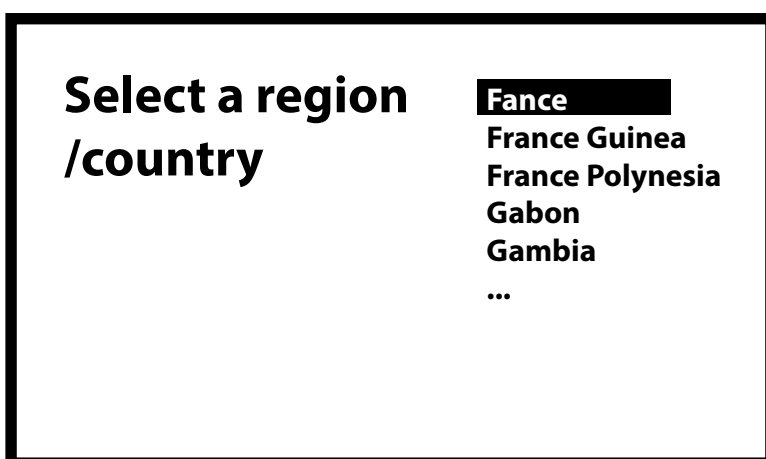

5.0 INSTALLATION LIVE TV APPLICATION MEW TV

Before you can start enjoying satellite TV and radio channels, you need to set up your preferred satellite and install the channels. Please follow the steps below:

1. Select the MEW TV application from the home screen.
2. Press OK to open the application.

Step 1: Country Select

If no channels have been installed before, a few explanation screens will appear first. Press **OK** to proceed until the *Country Select* menu appears on the screen.

By default, the country is set to Germany, which allows you to load a pre-installed channel list for Germany without needing to perform a satellite scan from ASTRA 19.2°E.

If you prefer to use a different satellite or perform a full auto scan, switch OFF the *Channel List Germany* or select another country. In this case, you will need to run a full channel scan.

Select *NEXT* and press *OK* to continue.

Step 2: FTI settings

The *FTI Settings* (First Time Installation) menu appears on the screen.

- Select *Subtitles* and press *OK* to switch ON or OFF, setting the default subtitle preference if available.
- Select *PIN Code* to set a parental PIN for protection before accessing certain channels. **Please note your PIN:**
- Select *Primary Audio* to set the first-priority audio language if available.
- Select *Secondary Audio* to set the second-priority audio language if available.
- Select *Finish* and press *OK* to proceed.

NOTE: If you selected *Pre-installed Channel List for Germany* in Step 1, you can start watching and enjoying satellite reception immediately.

For other selections, proceed to Step 3.

Step 3: Antenna setup

This menu allows you to select the antenna/dish system and start an automatic channel scan for your preferred satellite.

- Select *Direct LNB* if your system has a direct cable connection to your satellite dish.
- Select *DiSEqC* if your system supports multiple satellite dish connections.
- Select *Sat CR* if you are using a Sat CR LNB or a system for multiple household connections.
- Select *Manage Satellite* to choose a satellite, add a new one, or modify settings such as LNB frequency type (useful for older models) and transponder frequency to optimize signal strength and quality.

After making your selection, press *OK* to confirm and proceed to the next step.

By default, the scan mode is set to *FTA Only*, meaning only Free-To-Air channels will be installed. Scrambled channels will be ignored, as this receiver does not support decryption. If you still wish to install scrambled channels, switch this setting OFF.

Once all settings are configured, select *Search* to start the auto-scan process. Please be patient, as the search may take a few minutes. Once complete, a message will appear confirming the scan is finished. Press *BACK* to start enjoying your satellite reception.

5.1 USING LIVE TV

To start watching satellite TV channels, select *MEW TV* from the home screen and press *OK*.

- If TV channels were found during installation, the application will open on a channel.
- If no channels were found, a "No Channels Available" message will appear. In this case, select *Installation* to open the channel scan menu, check if the correct country is selected, and follow the on-screen instructions to (re)install TV channels.

When using Live TV for the first time, an on-screen guide will explain the navigation buttons. Use these buttons or press *OK* to go through and confirm the explanations.

Navigation Controls in Normal View Mode:

- ▲ Switch to next channel in channel list
- ▼ Switch to previous channel in channel list
- Call the channel list

OK Open the main menu from Live Tv app.

1~9 to select directly channel number

◀ Step back in the menu or exit the information.

- NOTE:** Some TV channels only transmit Dolby sound tracks. In this case, the volume cannot be adjusted via the Google TV box's volume controls. Instead:
- Use the remote control of your TV or Dolby audio amplifier.
 - Alternatively, set up volume control via *Settings Set up remote control buttons* to enable control through the HDMI CEC protocol.

6.0 PREFERENCES SETUP LIVE TV

If you want to start a new automatic scan, edit or sort channels, set the default audio track, or configure the Parental Control PIN, access the TV Options menu:

1. Press **OK**
 2. Press ▼
 3. Press ► twice
 4. Confirm with **OK** to open Settings and access the submenus.
- Additionally, by pressing **OK**, you will find quick access menus to:

- *EPG* (Electronic Program Guide)
- *Schedules*
- *Subtitles*
- *Multi-Audio*

6.1 Customize channel list

This menu allows you to Sort by Group, Move, or Delete channels from the channel list.

Move Channels:

1. Select the channel you want to move in the channel list.
2. Press **OK** briefly to select it.
3. Use ▲▼ to move it to the desired position.
4. Press **OK** again to confirm the new position.
5. If you need to correct the position, press **EXIT** and re-enter this menu.

Delete Channels:

1. Select the channel you want to delete from the channel list.
2. Press and hold **OK** for one second to confirm its deletion.

6.2 Manage my Favorite

This menu allows you to create and manage favorite (FAV) lists.

- **Add New Group:** Create a new favorite group and assign it a custom name.
- **Edit Existing FAV List:** Select an already created FAV list to add or remove channels.

You can access these lists later by pressing **OK** twice while in viewing mode.

6.3 Parental control

This menu allows you to protect channels with rating levels and block channels with a PIN code. You can also create a new PIN code. To access this menu, enter the PIN code you created during the initial installation. Channels with a parental rating above the chosen age will be protected with a PIN code (if available in your local broadcast).

- **On/Off:** Press **OK** to switch parental controls On or Off.
- **Program Restrictions:** Choose the country(ies) rating system you want to use for control.
- **Ratings:** Select between None, High, Medium, or Low restrictions.
- **Custom:** Select manual and age rating restrictions.
- **Channels Blocked:** Mark all programs/channels you want to lock. You can select the lock separately for each channel you would like to protect with a PIN code.

- **Change PIN Code:** Press **OK** to enter this submenu. Enter your current PIN code (4 digits), then enter your new PIN code (4 digits) and re-enter it to confirm. The new PIN will be automatically saved.

6.4 Video Display

This menu allows you to change the video screen size between Original scale, Full screen, or use the Zoom function.

7.0 PREFERENCES AUDIO / SUBTITLES

For the priority settings of audio and subtitles, follow these steps:

1. In viewing mode, open the *TV Options* menu by clicking **OK**, **▼**, and then **►** three times.
2. Confirm with **OK** to open the *Settings* and the submenus.
3. Select either *Audio* or *Subtitles* and then choose from the submenus below.

7.1 Default audio language

Primary audio: Use **▲▼** to select the audio language you want to hear as the first priority, if available.

Secondary audio: Use **▲▼** to select a language that will be played when the language selected for Primary Audio isn't available.

7.2 Default subtitle language

Primary language: Use **▲▼** to select the first preferred subtitle language.

Secondary language: Use **▲▼** to select the second preferred subtitle language

7.3 Audio description

Select here if you would like to hear the audio description track, if available on the channel.

The audio description provides narration of the events happening on the channel.

7.4 Subtitles

Select here to set your primary and secondary subtitle language preferences.

Primary language: Use **▲▼** to select the language you want to see as the first priority, if available.

Secondary language: Use **▲▼** to select a language that will be displayed when the language selected for the primary subtitle is not available.

7.5 Zapping mode

Select here the *channel zap/switching mode* you wish.

Freeze will keep displaying the last video frame until the next channel starts to play.

Black will display a black screen between channel switching.

7.6 Channel search

This menu allows you to search for (again) channels from satellite automatically. Be aware that all previously installed channels and *favorite list(s)* will be deleted. The newfound channels will be installed in the *channel list*, and afterwards, you can create a new *favorite list* if you like. Select *Scan* and choose between *Auto*, which will install all found channels, or *Transponder*, to scan only on one selected frequency. Highlight *Search* and press **OK** to start scanning.

7.7 Factory RESET (Live TV only)

If you would like to do a factory reset only for the *Live TV* application without resetting the Android part, then select *Reset* and confirm to delete all settings and *channel lists*. This will allow you to install the satellite part from the beginning through the installation wizard.


7.8 InfoBar setting






Select the time you want the *zap information banner* to display on screen after a channel switch. Choose between: *Never*, *3 sec*, *5 sec*, or *9 sec*.

7.9 About


In this last menu item, you can find the version of the *Live TV application*. For technical support or at the request of the helpdesk, you can switch the *Diagnostic mode* to *On*. This will display additional data on screen, such as PID's, frequency, and signal strength information.

8.0 USING ANDROID


Press on the  button to select the android home page where you can start your journey.

This is the start page which allows you to select MEW Live TV app, your favourite applications as YouTube, to search for movies and new to be installed apps. Use the navigation buttons   and   to select and with **OK** confirm selection. To exit or one step back use  button.

Press  to access directly android system menus to change settings and setup connections as Wi-Fi and Blue tooth. (Chapter 9)

Press  to call Google Assistance with voice control functions. (Chapter 10)

9.0 SETTINGS

Select Settings to check the device information, add/remove accounts and make changes to the system settings. Remove apps, set date & time, select audio and screen settings, Factory reset and lot more... Press  to access directly or through Home menu to select item in the upper right corner.

9.1 Set your device name

Select a name here that will help you identify the connection when you transmit or establish it from other devices.

9.2 Display and sound

Select *Display and sound* to change the Screen resolution, Audio formats and set up HDMI CEC Control.

By default, the screen resolution is automatically set to the best and maximum resolution of the connected TV. If you wish, you can switch to lower resolutions and switch off the HDR function. Select *HDMI CEC* to setup the control of the remote control from the devices and connected TV.

Select the *Advanced and Sound* settings to choose between stereo and Dolby audio and to activate the S/PDIF output.

Find under *Display and sound* *Advanced sound settings* *Select formats* *None* to set only to Stereo audio. Select *Automatic* to use all audio formats supported by this device including Dolby Digital.

9.3 Network and Internet

Select and enable Wi-Fi in order to connect wireless to the network.

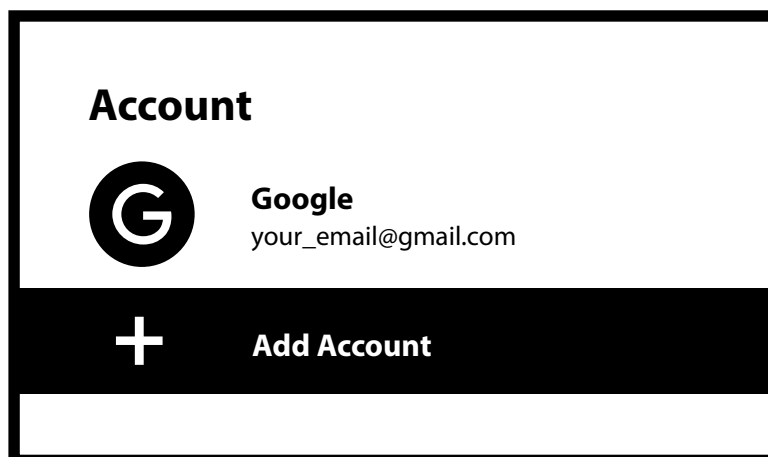
Once the device scans and lists nearby Wi-Fi networks, select the appropriate network name, if required put in the password and select **OK**.

If you use an RJ45 cable between the Android box and the router for the Internet connection.

You can find under *Ethernet* *Connected* whether the connection has been established correctly. If *Not Connected* is displayed, the cable is not plugged in or you want to use Wi-Fi instead.

NOTE: You can only use one connection at same time. Wi-Fi or Cable. Not both.

9.4 Accounts and sign in



Find here the current account you did use in first setup.
If you like to add a new account(s), then switch to new one or delete one.

9.5 Apps

Find here all installed apps on your box. If you want you can remove them or see permission which access, they have or require. Please, be careful if you do change some or remove apps. This can lead to instability of their functions.

9.6 System

Here you will find all settings such as information about the device and the software version, time and date, language selection, keyboard type, display and sound, storage space, activation of Google Assistance and Chromecast, energy saving settings, location and accessibility.

9.6.1 About Information

Under Settings *System*, select *About* to find device name and software information.
Select *System update* to check if a new software is available.
Select *Factory reset* to reset or to erase everything. (See Chapter 11)

WARNING: After an update the receiver restarts automatically. During the upgrade process NEVER disconnect the receiver from the mains or switch off the power! Doing so might damage your receiver and will void warranty!

9.6.2 Date and Time

Select *Date and Time* to change manual the time zone and the display format (24/12hour).

9.6.3 Language Settings

Select *Language* to change the language previously set.

9.6.4 Keyboard

The default keyboard is the basic type called *Gboard*. This menu allows you to switch to other keyboard types.

9.6.5 Storage

The *Memory* menu allows you to check the remaining space for both internal and external memory.

9.6.6 Ambient mode

The *Display* menu allows you to set a different wallpaper, as well as configure the weather and time for the home screen.

9.6.7 Power and energy

The *Power Management* menu allows you to adjust the automatic standby time. By default, the Google TV box switches to standby if the remote control is not used for 3 hours. If a message appears after 3 hours prompting standby mode, pressing any button on the remote will extend viewing for another 3 hours. This feature helps reduce power consumption if you forget to switch to standby. You can select a different time duration in this menu.

9.7 Remote and accessories

Select the option *Add accessory* for Bluetooth pairing of a new remote or device.
To remove, rename, find details of a Bluetooth device, choose this device which is shown under *Remote & Accessories* and press **OK** to access.


9.8 Set up remote buttons

Select option *Add device* for control with included Android remote another device such as TV, Soundbar or AV receiver. These must be connected by HDMI cable. Selections are Volume, Standby and Source input of TV screen. To set up these buttons need internet connection to be active as codes will be controlled from internet server.

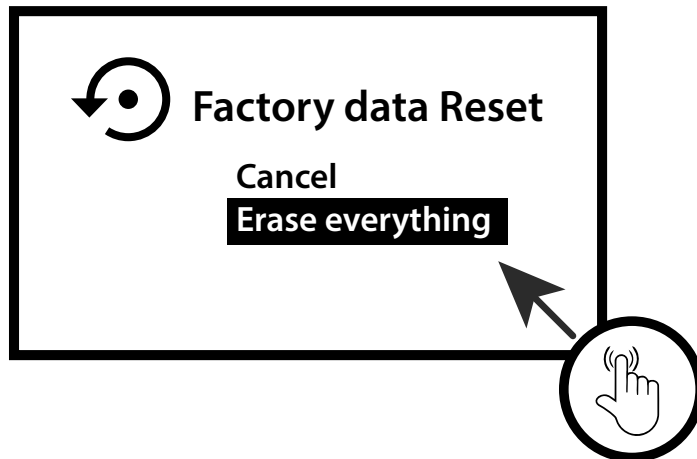
11.0 FACTORY RESET
