1.0 INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the FHD TV Stick supplied by STRONG. It has been produced with the latest new technology and offers extensive entertainment and great versatility. We wish you many hours of new great experiences exploring the Android world!

1.1 Safety Instructions

Read all the instructions before operating the device. Keep these instructions well for later use.

Only use attachments/accessories specified or provided by the manufacturer (such as the exclusive supply adapter, battery etc.).

- Please refer to the information on the product enclosure for electrical and safety information before installing or operating the apparatus.
- To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this apparatus to rain or moisture.
- The ventilation should not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings with items, such as newspaper, table-cloths, curtains, etc.
- The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus.

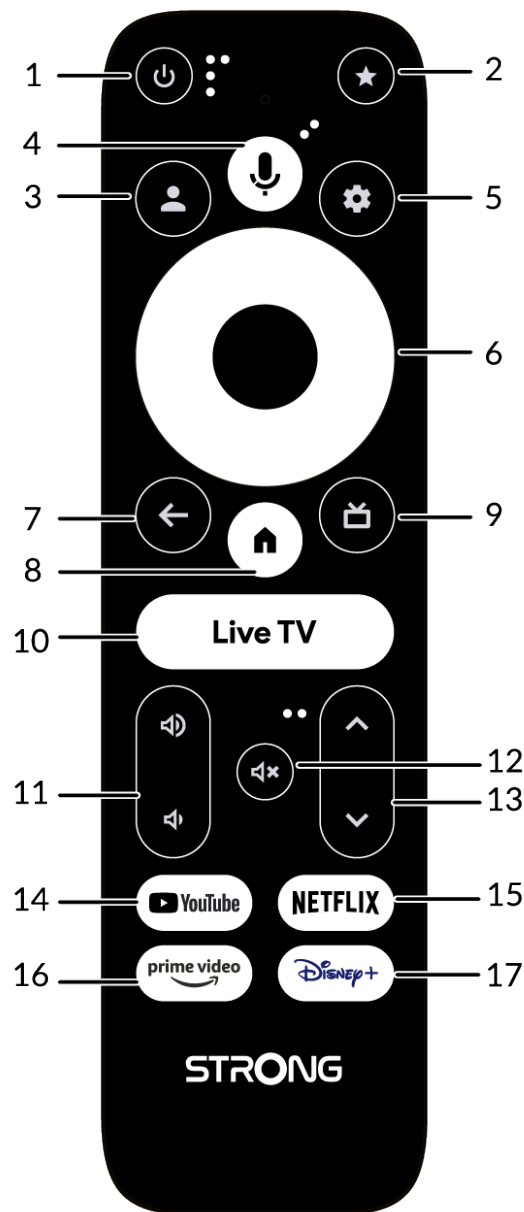

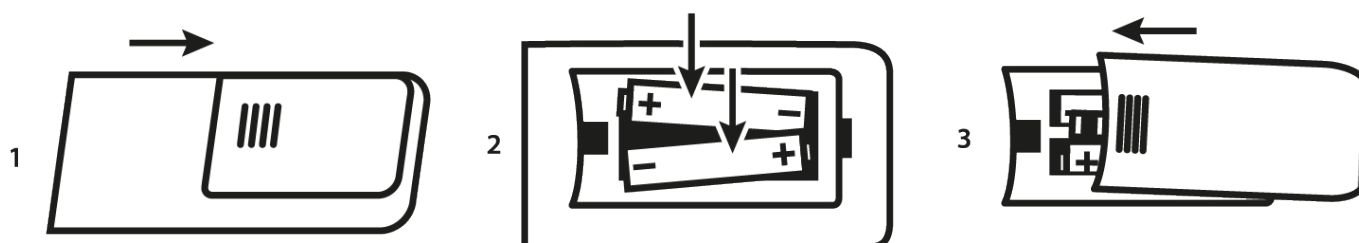

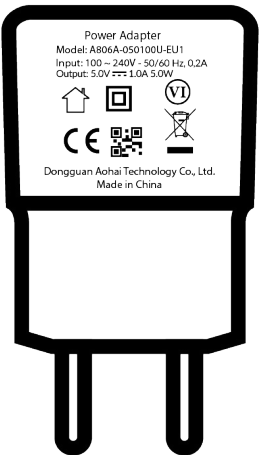


Open the cover on the remote control and insert 2x AAA batteries into the compartment. The correct position of batteries polar diagram is shown inside the batteries compartment.

1. Open the cover.
2. Insert the batteries.
3. Close the lid.

2.4 Power adapter



The device is supplied with a power adapter (Model: A806A-050100U-EU1), manufactured by Dongguan Aohai Technology Co., Ltd., and made in China. It is designed to operate with an input voltage of 100–240 V at a frequency of 50/60 Hz, with a current of 0.2 A. The adapter provides an output of 5.0 V and 1.0 A, with a maximum power of 5.0 W.

The symbols on the adapter indicate the following:

- CE indicates conformity with applicable European regulations
- Indoor use symbol: for indoor use only
- Double insulation symbol: Class II equipment, no protective earth required
- Crossed-out wheeled bin: do not dispose of with household waste; follow local recycling regulations
- Efficiency Level VI: meets energy efficiency requirements for external power supplies

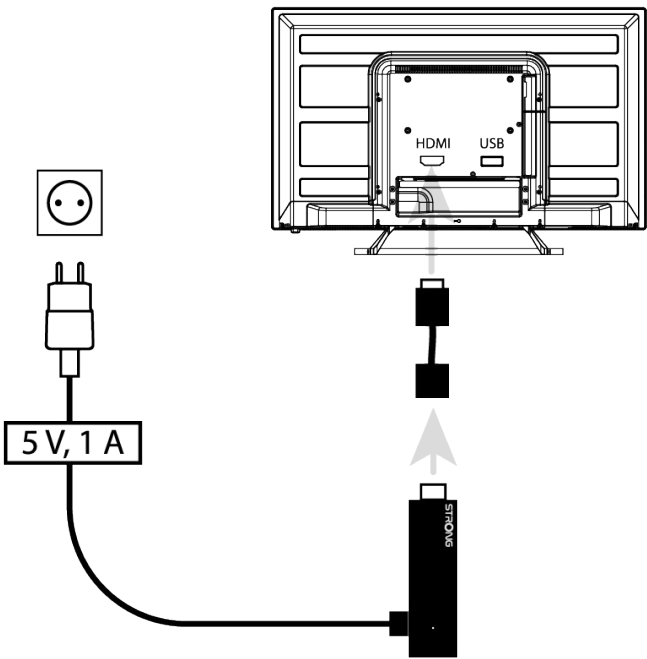

3.0 CONNECTION GUIDE

Refer to the diagram below for connecting your Google TV Stick to the TV.

NOTE: Before getting started, please turn off all devices to be connected.

Connect the TV stick to your television on available HDMI port. Connect one end of the USB-C cable into LEAP-UNA+ USB-C port. The other end of this cable into USB power adaptor. Now, Insert the USB power adaptor into the wall outlet.

NOTE: The LEAP-UNA+ stick supports Wi-Fi 2.4GHz and 5 GHz. To connect, go to Settings - Network.

NOTE: Before turning on your device, please switch the signal input of the TV to the correct source

4.0 SETTING UP YOUR DEVICE

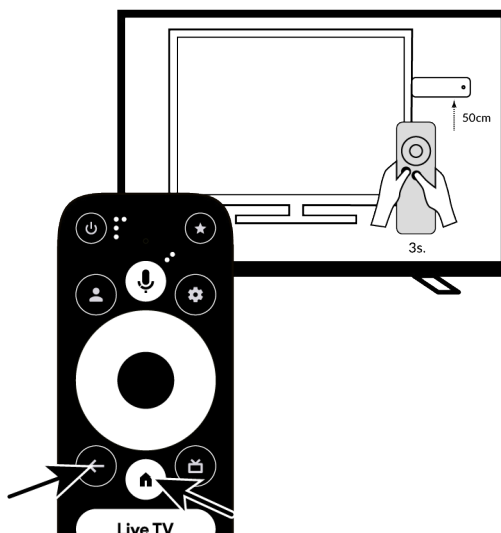
You may turn on your TV after properly connecting is done in above step 3.

Select on TV the HDMI entrée port where this TV stick is inserted to. Wait until the menu appears on screen. To be able to use the Bluetooth Remote control and Google Assistant, you must first pair the Remote to your TV Stick. To do so, click on any button of the remote control, and then press at same time ← & 🏠 button for 3 seconds until the LED on remote is blinking green.

The pairing will now start and if successful it will go automatically to the next step in installation wizard.

Please, follow the pairing instructions on the screen.

NOTE: You can also pair the remote control with the following reset operation: Power off the remote control, hold the return key without releasing it and Power on the remote control.

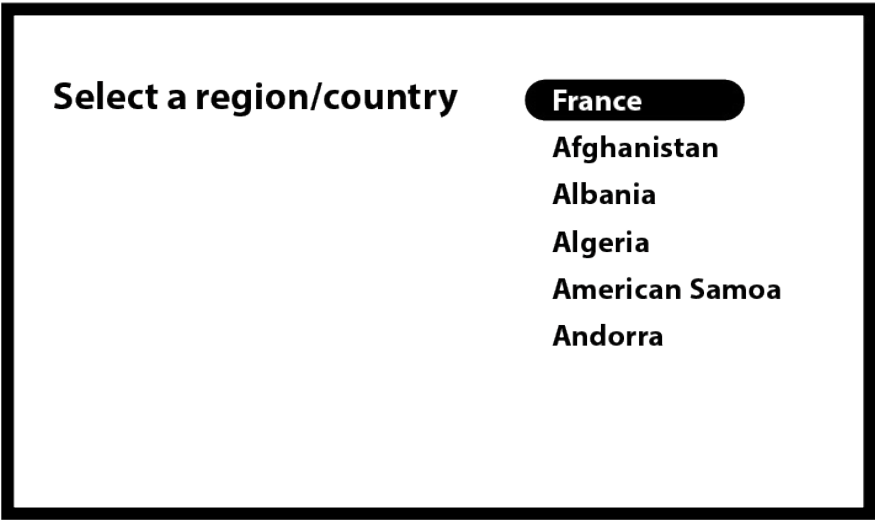

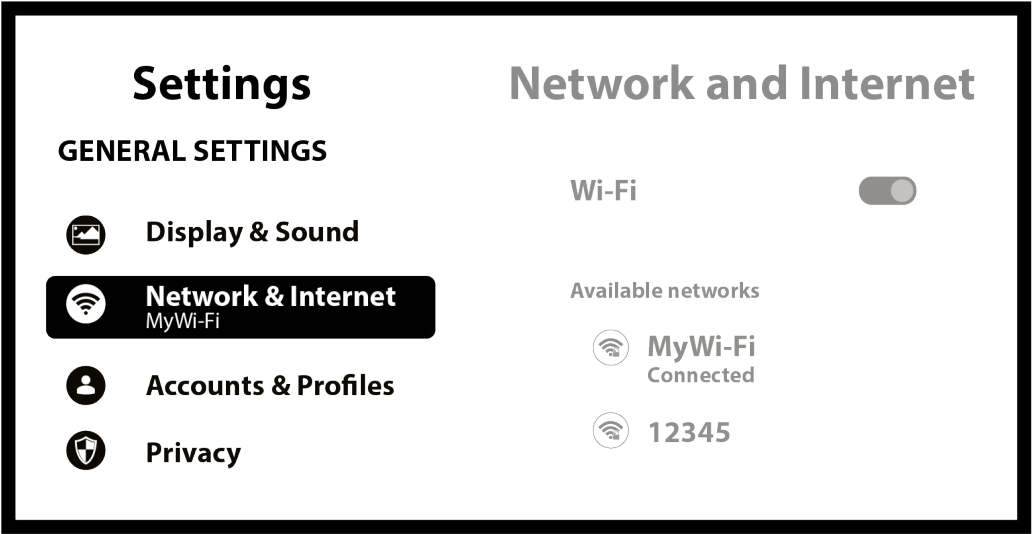
5.0 SETTINGS

6.0 DOWNLOADING APPS

Apps are available for download from the Google Play Store. On the home screen, select "Apps" to explore and download your desired applications. Or you can select in this application *Search* and type the name or press the microphone and say the name of the app you want to install. If the app appears on the screen, select *Install* to begin the installation of the app.





7.0 DEVICES PREFERENCE

This is the main menu to select to set up or change settings such as: Time & date, Language, Keyboard, Display & sound, Screen saver, Chromecast functions, Energy saver and location.

Date & Time

Select the time zone where you are using this device to match the local time.
You can also choose the time format: 12-hour or 24-hour clock.

Language Settings

Under *Settings > System* select *Language* to change the language previously set.

Keyboard

If you like to use other types of keyboard layout, select here the type you like.

Display & sound

Under this menu select:
Display Format > Screen resolution to change Resolution, Color space and HDR policy.
Display setting > Switch On or Off AIPQ (AI supported Picture Quality), change peak luminance
CEC input > CEC switch > to let TV control connected device, change Advanced CEC settings
Audio > Select off or on the click sound when you press button on remote.

The advanced sound settings option allows you to select the audio format provided by the chosen application. You can either keep it set to *Auto* or select *OFF* to use only the PCM (stereo) audio format.

Google assistance

Use the microphone on the remote for Google-Assistant-related functions, like searching for apps, videos or even ask questions.

8.0 GOOGLE CAST

This device has Google Cast built-in which allows you to cast content from an Android phone or tablet to your TV screen. Simply to open a Google cast compatible app on your mobile device. Navigate to the screen you wish to cast. To cast from Google Chrome, click the Settings icon : located on the top right corner of the browser on your phone or tablet, then click "Cast". Select the screen to which you want to cast the content. To stop casting, just select again this icon and select "Stop casting".

Cast

Under this menu item, select the Notification settings you prefer. Select options: *Always, while casting* or *Never*.

Ambient Screen saver

Select here selected time that screensaver needs to start when there is no activity.

Power& Energy saver

Select here selected time to turn off the display screen when there is no activity at all.

Default is set to 3 hours. Options: 15min, 30min, 1, 3, 4, 8, 12, 24 hours or never.

Location

Google uses your location to enhance performance and improve user experience while using apps.

Select the *Location Status* to activate or turn *Off*.

9.0 REMOTE & ACCESSORIES

This menu allows you to add new Bluetooth devices. Like remote, keyboard, speakers.

Bluetooth Pairing

Select *Add accessories* and press *OK* on the remote to start searching for other Bluetooth devices. If any devices are found, they will appear on the right side of the menu. Select the device you want to pair and press *OK* again. In some cases, you may need to enter a PIN code to complete the pairing process. Follow the instructions on screen in this case.

Remove a Bluetooth Device

Select the Bluetooth device you want to remove from the access list under the *Remote & Pairing* menu.

Press *OK* on the selected device to open options to Remove (Forget, Unpair) or Rename the device.

The battery level of the selected remote will be displayed.

Setup remote buttons

To control volume, power, input on TVs, receivers and soundbars. Select which device and which setting you want to control by CEC with the TV stick remote control.

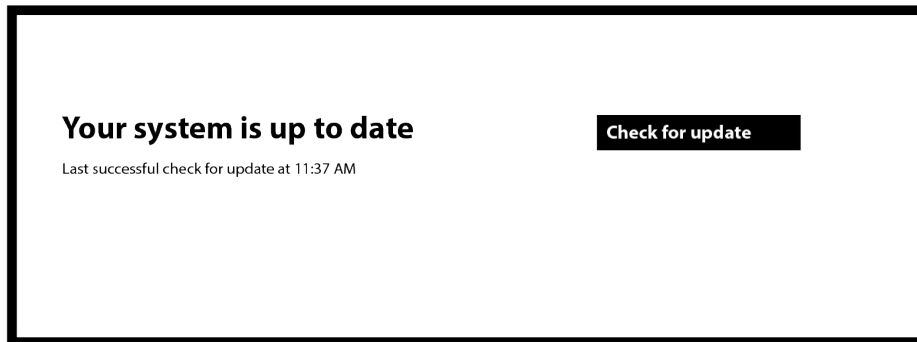
Control of volume through CEC function

This screen allows you to set up volume control for other connected devices, such as your TV, soundbar, or amplifier, using this Android remote. The control is sent via the HDMI port using the CEC protocol. To use this function, ensure the CEC function is enabled on the connected device.

Factory reset

If the Android stick reacts strangely, even after checking all settings or if you want to remove all accounts and apps and restore the device to its original state, select *Factory reset* to reset or restore.

Under *Settings* select *Device PreferencesAboutFactory reset*, Press *OK* and confirm *Factory data reset* to erase everything.

Once this option has been selected, all manually installed apps and user data will be permanently deleted.

NOTE: Account(s) will also be deleted.

11.0 GOOGLE ASSISTANT

NOTE: To be able to use Google Assistant on your remote, you must first pair your Bluetooth Remote to your TV Stick.

Say it to Play it.

Ask it to play your favorite show, video, or music. Or find the latest blockbuster to enjoy.

12.0 SIMPLE TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Reason	Solution
No LED of menu display after power on	The power adapter is not properly connected	Make Sure the device is connected to the power
No Sound	The Tv is on Mute or volume is low. The device is on Mute or the volume is too low.	Press the 4* button to restore the sound and increase the volume.
Failed to connect to network	Wi-Fi is turned off or the signal is too weak.	Restart the Wi-Fi or adjust the position of the device closer to the router.
Remote Control Failure Not possible to use and control.	Lost pairing to TV stick Remote control batteries are low in power. Remote is broken	Call Bluetooth Pairing to pair again. Follow Remove power, Insert power wait until "Google LOGO" appears on screen. Press on remote ← & ↵ for 3 seconds until LED is blinking, wait until pair screen appears. Now it will pair. If paired, LED on remote will light up Green. Replace batteries or send the device to the local maintenance service station for checking.
